OCTOBER, 1952

The tonnage of revenue carried during October at 15,037,487 tons failed to equal the record for the month of 15,597,351 tons attained in 1951 but surpassed the similar period of 1950 when 14,994,777 tons were reported. The decrease from October, 1951 was thus 3.6 p.c. or 559,864 tons with only the manufactures and miscellaneous commodity group showing a minor betterment. Loadings at Canadian stations were down from 12,047,614 to 11,527,307 tons, receipts from connections for domestic delivery improved 28,028 tons to 2,101,090 but intranait freight volume dropped to 1,409,190 tons from 1,476,675 tons one year earlier.

A comparison of provincial loadings in the previous October indicates an increase of 769 tons in Newfoundland to 113,814 tons, with gains in manufactures and animal products. Despite a sharp rise in agricultural shipments, the Prince Edward Island total was down from 26,558 to 22,850 tons as pulpwood deliveries sagged badly from 15,397 to 1,101 tons. For Nova Scotia the October total was 910,979 tons against 933,550 tons with forest products lower. Similarly in New Brunswick, the precipitous decline in pulpwood shipments moved the provincial total down from 442,884 to 314,462 tons. The province of Quebec reported 1,729,174 tons loaded during the month for a decline of 8.8 p.c. centered around the forestry items and manufactures.

Rail shipments of agricultural commodities were reduced in Ontario as well as mine and manufactured items and the regional volume shrank from 4,019,977 to 3,808,440 tons or by 5.3 p.c. Despite the heavy grain crop, the Manitoba aggregate was reduced from 1,116,737 to 839,639 tons as agricultural products dropped 237,363 tons to 437,815 tons. Mine output was also lower. The province of Saskatchewan registered a minor improvement with the monthly total at 1,389,311 tons or 57,760 tons above October of 1951. Manufactures and miscellaneous gained 16,651 tons with gasoline and petroleum business returning to the rails. Alberta posted the most encouraging gains of any province as the area aggregate moved up from 1,302,309 to 1,415,788 tons for a rise of nearly 18 p.c.; agricultural, mine and manufactures shipments posted increases. The British Columbia volume was up from 965,538 to 982,750 tons as agricultural products, mine and manufactures were also heavier.

Total domestic loadings in October were lighter in all main commodity groups. Agricultural commodities eased from 3,123,415 to 3,070,163 tons. Wheat shipments were down 324,831 to 1,469,525 tons but corn, oats, barley, rye, flaxseed and other grains were much heavier. Barley rose from 342,256 to 436,432 tons. Flour, apples and potatoes also posted gains. The Animals and Animal Products group showed a minor decline of 3,511 tons to 130,123. Livestock continued lower but hogs and dressed meats improved.

Among mineral items coke, stone, crude petroleum, asphalt and other mine products were heavier but the group total dropped 100,208 tons to 4,130,371 tons. The steep recession in pulpwood deliveries from 656,489 to 417,225 tons and a decrease of 62,728 tons in lumber pushed the forest products loadings down from 1,507,018 to 1,229,995 tons, off 18.4 p.c. from the previous October. Logs, ties, plywood and other forest products, however, were improved. Manufactured and miscellaneous items totalled 2,966,554 tons for the month or 86,414 tons under the corresponding period of 1951. Gains were recorded in gasoline, petroleum oils, rails, cement, brick, furniture, beverages, and miscellaneous manufactures. Iron and steel shipments were 30,861 tons lighter at 134,427 while newsprint slipped from 313,076 tons in the previous October to 287,542 tons. L.C.L. freight at 301,862 tons compared with 220,696 tons in the same month a year earlier.

The Cumulative total of all freight carried during the first ten months indicates a record 135,155,177 tons were handled for an increase of 1,643,008 tons or 1.2 p.c. over the similar span of 1951 and compares with 118,180,427 tons in 1950. To the end of October, 1942 some 98,133,512 tons were carried, an advance of nearly 38 p.c. being shown in the decade.
