MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA

DECEMBER, 1952

A record for the month of 12,980,254 tons of revenue freight were moved on Canadian lines during December, representing an advance of 777,591 tons or 6.4 p.c. over the same month of 1951 and 927,392 tons better than December of 1950. Canadian stations billed 10,138,708 tons of the current total against 9,386,592 tons a year earlier and accounted for the bulk of the increase. Receipts for domestic delivery from abroad were down slightly from 1,535,425 to 1,510,946 tons while intrasit freight totalled 1,330,600 tons against 1,280,646 tons during December of 1951.

Loadings in Canada posted encouraging gains in each of the five commodity groups. Activity may have been spurred to some extent by the freight rate increase scheduled for January 1st. Agricultural Products totalled 2,962,056 tons compared with 2,501,068 tons a year earlier for an 18.4 p.c. rise. Wheat was up from 1,387,263 to 1,773,812 tons and barley, rye, flaxseed, flour, other mill products, and potatoes were much heavier. Featured by recovery in livestock and meat deliveries following the embargoes, the Animals and Products class increased from 93,081 to 130,999 tons or by nearly 40 p.c. Mine Products amounted to 3,018,657 tons against 2,908,159, gains in coke, other ores, base bullion, stone, and in crude petroleum up from 31,763 to 79,236 tons, offsetting declines in coal, iron ore, copper ore and other mine products. Forest items totalled 1,266,272 tons, up from 1,258,090 tons in the previous December. Logs at 214,464 compared with 180,485 tons a year earlier. Fires increased by some 10,321 tons to 14,628, reflecting activity in railway construction both east and west. Pulpwood continued far below 1951 levels shrinking from 560,484 to 378,376 tons. Lumber deliveries were much better moving up from 440,660 to 575,035 tons. Plywood more than doubled at 27,743 tons versus 11,072 a year earlier.

Advances predominated among the Manufactures and Miscellaneous commodities with the total increasing 135,420 tons to 2,761,614 tons. Gasoline totalled 258,635 versus 202,336 tons and oils were up 25,364 tons to 357,876. Sugar, rails, and iron and steel were improved while cement rose from 88,412 to 127,161 tons. Brick, lime and plaster, agricultural implements, furniture, beverages and fertilizers joined in the advance. L.C.L. merchandise showed 171,578 tons against 163,242 tons in the preceding December. Declines were indicated in pig iron, castings, autos, other paper, woodpulp off from 193,714 to 167,045 tons in fish and in other manufactures. Newsprint paper registered a minor gain from 303,777 to 307,530 tons.

Import freight was higher in the recent December in agricultural, forest and manufactured products. Fresh fruits and vegetables, lumber, other ores and concentrates, oils, brick and artificial stone, implements, autos, beverages, other manufactures and L.C.L. imports were higher. Anthracite coal dropped from 342,641 to 168,442 tons.

Provincial loadings show increases over December, 1951 in eight of the ten provinces. The Newfoundland aggregate moved up from 49,760 to 67,544 tons with all commodity groups higher this December. A sharp drop in pulpwood requirements forced the Prince Edward Island total down to 34,529 tons from 37,053 despite a good advance in agricultural commodities. Similarly, lower forest output pared the Nova Scotia total from 773,295 to 762,535 tons. New Brunswick posted a minor increase of 3,542 tons to 333,848. In Quebec recession in forest items kept the provincial total at 1,456,777 tons compared with 1,429,370 tons a year earlier for a gain of 27,407 tons. The Ontario total likewise moved up slightly from 2,998,326 to 3,065,852 tons as forest products were lower against gains in agriculture and animal shipments. Manitoba stations billed 591,927 tons during December for an increase of 82,526 tons or 16 p.c. Grains and mine items improved considerably. The Saskatchewan aggregate at 1,397,169 tons rose from 1,253,817 a year earlier due mainly to grain and petroleum products. Alberta continued to reflect a booming prosperity, leading 1,381,894 for an increase of 188,097 tons or 15.7 p.c. British Columbia also reflected great activity with 1,046,533 tons of revenue freight against 811,467 tons in December of 1951 and 862,954 tons a year earlier.

The preliminary cumulative total for all freight carried during 1952 is a record 161,905,537 tons compared with a revised 160,252,638 tons in 1951 and 144,030,623 tons in 1950. The increase over 1951 is thus 1,652,899 tons or 1 p.c. A detailed analysis of 1952 traffic will appear in the "Summary of Monthly Traffic Reports, 1952" which will be issued later in bulletin form.

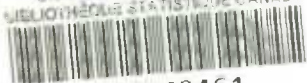
