Canadian railways reported a new record for the period in the volume of revenue freight handled during February when 12,491,148 tons were moved compared with 11,205,530 tons in the corresponding month of 1951 and the previous peak for the period of 11,288,311 tons in 1948. The extra day this year accounted for some of the advance, but the increase over 1951 was 1,285,618 tons or 11.5 p.c. Canadian commodities represented 9,412,310 tons of the total against 8,280,197 tons loaded at domestic stations one year earlier. Foreign connections supplied 3,078,838 tons of which 1,580,568 was for delivery in Canada and 1,498,270 tons intransit. Both groups showed a gain over February last year when 1,517,510 and 1,407,823 tons respectively were recorded.

Loadings in the Atlantic Provinces were lighter in the current February but for Quebec to the West Coast impressive gains were shown. The Newfoundland total was down 6,396 tons to 42,115 with reduced manufactured items, the Prince Edward Island aggregate at 16,559 shrank from 41,243 tons due mainly to greatly lowered potato deliveries which were only 7,739 tons against 23,064 tons one year earlier. Pulpwood dropped from 12,557 to 3,275 tons as local demand slackened. In Nova Scotia volume was slightly under the previous February with this year's loadings at 792,864 tons versus 800,781. Bituminous coal was off nearly 40,000 tons despite the extra day this February. In New Brunswick lighter pulpwood and lumber shipments caused a drop of 34,805 tons in the provincial total to 391,646 tons.

The province of Quebec reported 1,547,053 tons against 1,378,650 tons last year, a betterment of 12.2 p.c. with mine, forest and manufactured products considerably higher. The Ontario total moved up from 3,001,960 tons to 3,330,650 tons as agricultural items, forest and manufactured products improved. In Manitoba a gain of 73,653 tons was indicated with the provincial total at 461,730 tons. Forest products jumped from 74,435 to 168,863 tons. Heavier grain loadings this February moved the Saskatchewan aggregate up from 635,725 to 974,161 tons or by over 53 p.c. Wheat more than doubled at 557,638 tons against 246,167 tons one year earlier. Oats and barley were also much heavier as well as forest products. Alberta posted gains in agricultural products, mine and forest as well as manufactured commodities. Wheat loaded at 245,758 tons compared with 166,061 tons in February of 1951. British Columbia showed worthwhile recovery in mine products, and in forest and manufactured groups. The provincial total of 820,322 versus 710,237 tons was up 15.5 p.c. Copper ores, logs and fertilizers were much heavier this February.

In total freight carried during the month under review commodities showing increases included wheat up from 702,210 to 1,118,171 tons, corn 15,589 tons heavier at 80,883, oats advancing 57,595 tons to 178,405 and barley 79,400 tons to 190,149. Hogs totalled 23,524 tons or 6,653 tons above the previous February. Other packing house products and cheese shipments showed betterment. Sub-bituminous coal and coke also increased with coke up 51,104 tons to 203,193. Ores were generally heavier and sand and gravel rose over 10 p.c. in volume. Among the forestry items logs gained 98,995 tons to 228,142 and pulpwood tonnage advanced 385,386 tons to 1,310,555 tons. Gasoline and petroleum oils, pig iron, rails and iron and steel shipments were greater with the last up 63,824 tons to 343,816 or by 22.8 p.c. Cement, beverages, fertilizers, newsprint and other paper, woodpulp and miscellaneous manufactures joined in the advance over February, 1951. Newsprint carried at 369,404 tons was up 33,572 tons. The principal declines occurred in flour, apples, livestock, dressed meats, butter, hides and leather. Coal was down 87,404 tons to 271,605 in anthracite grades and 30,422 tons to 1,240,620 in bituminous. Lumber dropped 61,438 tons to 495,752 tons. Manufactured items were generally higher but L.C.L. merchandise shrank 24,712 tons to 218,330 tons down 10.1 p.c. Cumulative totals for the first two months indicate an increase of 2,099,743 tons or 8.9 p.c. over the similar period of 1951 in total freight carried and represent a new record at 25,575,495 tons. In the corresponding months of 1942 under war pressure only 18,555,956 tons were carried. The increase in the last decade was thus nearly 38 p.c. illustrating a tremendous advance in national productivity.
