MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA

MARCH, 1952

A grand total of 12,909,768 tons of revenue freight was carried by Canadian railroads during March to register an increase of 357,108 tons or 2.8 p.c. over the corresponding period last year. The current total compares favourably with 1950 and 1949 when March volume was 11,777,322 and 12,111,680 tons respectively. The peacetime record for the month of 13,242,676 tons was established in 1948. Traffic handled during the first quarter of 1952 reached 38,485,253 tons, up 2,456,951 tons or 6.8 p.c. above the same period of 1951 and is a new all-time high.

Loadings at Canadian stations during March amounted to 9,750,972 tons, a betterment of 606,687 tons or 6.6 p.c. over the previous March and mainly reflecting the increased grain movement. Receipts from foreign connections were reduced from 3,408,355 to 3,158,785 tons but deliveries to domestic points were slightly heavier. The decline was entirely in intransit freight in which all five commodity groups were lower this March.

Much heavier loadings in the Provinces of Ontario, Saskatchewan and Alberta accounted for the rise in the national total over last year. Ontario moved up from 3,286,552 to 3,537,410 tons on the strength of gains in agricultural products. The Saskatchewan aggregate soared to 948,592 tons from 618,142 tons one year earlier, a rise of 83 p.c. with grain up spectacularly. Alberta posted a gain of 166,462 tons to 875,678 tons with grains and manufactures featured. Improvement was also shown for Newfoundland up from 40,124 to 44,802 tons and in British Columbia where loadings were 860,390 tons or 12,995 tons above March of 1951. Pulpwood and potato reductions brought the Prince Edward Island total down to 30,578 tons from 47,041 tons one year earlier. Decreases were reported for Nova Scotia off 5.5 p.c., New Brunswick volume down 22 p.c. and Manitoba 6 p.c. The province of Quebec had 1,760,027 tons during the month under review for a drop of 43,197 tons with all groups except forest items somewhat lighter this March.

Comparing total freight carried during the month with the same period of 1951, increases were indicated in agricultural and in forest products. The agricultural group rose 721,204 tons to 2,572,541 with wheat nearly doubling, up 880,796 tons to 1,345,811 tons. Oats, barley, rye and flaxseed were much better but corn and most other items were lower. Potatoes advanced 24,694 tons to 97,331 due to heavier imports and intransit traffic. The animals and animal products group continued lower due in part to sharp reductions in livestock and meats and dairy products. The group total was off 54,710 tons to 111,255. Livestock dropped from 27,610 to 10,943 tons and fresh meats were reduced from 34,103 to 15,221 tons with the western embargoes contributing. Mine products totalled 3,750,553 and showed a minor decrease of 56,104 tons from the previous March, largely in bituminous coal and sand and gravel. The total movement of anthracite, iron ore, and other ores showed good gains. Advances in logs and pulpwood more than counterbalanced a drop in lumber shipments and the forest products aggregate moved up from 2,094,660 to 2,156,873 tons. The lumber total was down 120,488 tons to 582,691 tons or by 17 p.c.

Declines in sixteen of the twenty-five manufactured commodities produced a decrease of 315,495 tons from the previous March total with this year's total at 4,318,536 tons. Gasoline, oils, iron and steel, cement, agricultural implements, fertilisers and other paper were moved in greater volume. Sizeable recessions were indicated in pig iron, building products, automobiles, newsprint, woodpulp, canned goods, miscellaneous manufactures and in L. C. L. merchandise which shrank 57,265 tons to 239,844 tons.
