MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA

The total tonnage of revenue freight carried by the principal railways in Canada during May amounted to 13,802,314 tons. This represents a minor decline of 72,103 tons or 0.5 p.c. from the record established for the month during the previous May but shows a good seasonal gain over April of this year when 12,561,643 tons were transported. The increase in the current May over May of 1950 was 9.5 p.c. while total volume was 27.3 p.c. above May, 1942.

Domestic loadings contributed 10,743,635 tons to the monthly total, up slightly from 10,738,450 tons in the previous May. Receipts from foreign connections, however, were 77,288 tons lighter this May at 3,058,679 tons with the decrease all in intransit freight. Revenue shipments destined to Canadian points from abroad rose from 1,598,762 to 1,839,251 tons due mainly to heavier crude bauxite deliveries. The sizeable overall advance in combined loadings and domestic receipts reflects a continued high level of industrial activity.

Increases in domestic volume were indicated in agricultural products up from 2,262,837 to 2,995,761, a gain of 32.3 p.c. Wheat shipments jumped 476,566 tons to 1,742,838 tons. Corn, oats, barley, rye and flaxseed were also much greater while flour, other mill products, apples, potatoes and vegetables dropped considerably. The animals and animal products group showed a decrease of 18,449 tons to 94,924 with livestock down sharply from 39,911 to 26,149. Hogs improved by 4,415 tons to 21,263 but dairy products continued to decline. The domestic mineral items grossed 3,265,934 tons for the month or 159,559 tons under May of last year. The wide decreases in iron ore and other mine products offset gains in sand and gravel, coke, non-ferrous metals and salt.

Due to drops in pulpwood and lumber shipments, forest products showed a reduction of 416,185 tons to 1,267,297 tons compared with 1,683,482 tons in the preceding May. Pulpwood loadings which had been very heavy in the first quarter began to lag in April and May this year. May tonnage at 450,854 was off from 815,449 tons a year ago. Lumber shipments were down to 51,182 from 626,589 tons but logs increased from 160,278 to 243,331 tons or by 51.8 p.c.

Domestic loadings of manufactured and miscellaneous items totalled 3,119,729 tons for the month down 4 p.c. or 133,536 tons from the preceding May. Heavy volumes were shown for gasoline, petroleum oils, iron and steel, cement, automobiles, and beverages up from 44,524 to 58,961 tons. The wider declines occurred in pig iron, fertilisers off from 242,997 to 226,871 tons, newsprint at 308,851 against 320,843 tons, paperboard, woodpulp down 69,620 tons to 150,801 and in L.C.L. freight at 208,639 tons versus 249,256 tons one year earlier.

Provincial loadings were lighter this May in Newfoundland where the regional total dropped to 87,098 tons from 147,107 tons, the large reduction in pulpwood deliveries, off 71,383 tons, accounting for the decrease. Mine products and manufactures showed gains. Prince Edward Island volume was also pared to 32,831 from 51,686 tons due to pulpwood decreasing from 20,782 to 1,441 tons. The total for Nova Scotia at 894,497 tons represents a decline of 30,987 tons or 3.4 p.c. and occurred in forest and manufactured items, mainly lumber, fertilisers, building products and miscellaneous manufactures. Similarly a drop of 104,112 tons in the New Brunswick aggregate mirrored a sharp lowering in the movement of pulpwood, and the provincial total slipped to 359,503 tons for May against 463,615 tons a year earlier.

Quebec loadings amounted to 1,666,233 tons compared with 1,912,957 in May, 1951 down 13 p.c. Agricultural and mine products were heavier this May but forest products registered a wide decrease with pulpwood dropping from 330,826 to 152,405 tons and lumber from 128,937 to 87,067 tons. Manufactured items slipped to 896,065 from 942,224 tons. In Ontario a minor drop was experienced with a total of 3,453,845 tons loaded against 3,529,898 tons one year earlier. Good gains were shown in agricultural products while the forestry total was maintained. Iron ore deliveries were down sharply from 457,334 to 237,371 tons. The Prairie provinces all posted encouraging advances, mainly in agricultural products. The Manitoba total moved up from 770,317 to 815,975 tons while Saskatchewan grossed 1,426,229 tons against 997,945 tons a betterment of 43 p.c. due largely to heavy shipments of wheat, oats and barley. Alberta had 1,078,205 tons or 103,466 tons above the previous May. All commodity groups were higher in the foothills province which is enjoying a diversified prosperity. British Columbia showed 929,219 tons loaded down 35,483 tons or 3.7 p.c. with the decline mainly in gasoline, fertilisers and miscellaneous manufactures.

The cumulative total of all freight carried by railways in Canada during the first five months of the current year was a new record of 64,849,210 tons, representing an increase of 3.7 p.c. or 2,331,869 tons over the similar period last year. This exceeds the wartime peak of 63,779,991 tons reported for the period January - May of 1944.

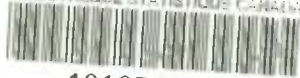
