Revenue freight carried by Canadian lines during July at 14,028,369 tons topped the previous record for the month last year when 13,977,167 tons were given railway movement. The minor gain of 51,202 tons reflects a higher level of agricultural and mining activity. The July, 1950 total was 12,361,846 tons while the wartime July of 1942 shows 12,331,792 tons.

Canadian freight stations loaded a peak 11,238,765 tons during the month against 10,678,229 tons in the preceding July, a betterment of 560,536 tons or 5.2 p.c. Receipts from connections, however, were lower. The total received for domestic consumption dropped from 1,902,527 to 1,719,570 tons and intransit freight declined from 1,396,411 to 1,070,034. These decreases reflected lower coal imports and the effects of the steel strike in the United States.

Domestic loadings of agricultural products were sharply higher this July with a total of 3,073,930 tons against 2,209,088 tons a year earlier. The gain of 864,842 tons or 39 p.c. was due to wide advances in wheat and grains. The total for wheat moved up from 1,285,170 to 1,853,381 tons under pressure of a bumper crop in sight and the availability of lake shipping idled by the iron ore and steel strikes across the border. Oats rose from 304,455 to 394,753 tons and barley was steeply higher at 397,596 tons against 230,762 tons in the preceding July. Rye shipments more than doubled at 53,536 tons and flour, cotton and other agricultural products were heavier. The animals and products group was off slightly from 97,450 to 96,538 tons with livestock lower and hogs and meats increased. The mine products class totalled 3,708,946 tons up 180,410 tons as bituminous coal, iron ore, sand and gravel and asphalt were much better. Forest items declined 425,276 tons to 1,542,645 as pulpwood shipments shrank from 1,061,297 to 811,346 tons and lumber was off 165,890 tons to 524,062 tons with B.C. operations slowed by labour trouble. Volume in the manufactures and miscellaneous group was nearly maintained; the total of 2,816,706 tons for the month compared with 2,874,234 tons a year earlier. Gains were secured in domestic loadings of gasoline, pig iron, rails, iron and steel, cement, agricultural implements, beverages, fertilizers and newsprint. Building products, automobiles, woodpulp, miscellaneous and L.C.L. freight were reduced.

A feature of foreign receipts was the sharp cut in iron and steel imports. Intransit freight, in line with reduced carloadings in the United States, was much lower for all classification groups except forest products. Encouraging gains this July were shown in a comparison of loadings according to province. Newfoundland volume moved up from 129,681 to 200,546 tons as mine and forest output improved considerably. The Nova Scotia total at 845,089 tons gained 23,372 tons with mine and manufactured items higher. Ontario posted an impressive 3,958,609 tons compared with 3,892,788 tons for July of 1951 and scored a good gain in agricultural items with other groups off to a minor degree. Manitoba stations reported 683,881 tons versus 659,327 tons during the same month a year earlier with mine products much improved. A wide advance was registered in Saskatchewan where the speed up in grain loadings pushed the provincial total to 1,365,838 tons from 1,004,279 tons in the previous July. Alberta volume was likewise bolstered by a doubling in grain shipments and the regional aggregate jumped from 855,979 to 1,247,921 tons. All commodity groups were higher as the province rejoiced in record economic activity. Declines were shown in the totals for Prince Edward Island down from 23,329 to 9,861 tons as pulpwood purchases shrank sharply. New Brunswick with reduced forest output loaded 321,165 tons off from 405,890 a year earlier. The province of Quebec had gains in several items but a wide drop in forestry products mainly pulpwood and lumber pared the area total to 1,804,935 tons this July against 2,014,196 tons in the same month of 1951, a decline of 10 p.c.

Total revenue freight carried by all lines to the end of July this year amounted to a record 92,350,413 tons, up 1,922,500 or 2.1 p.c. over the similar period of 1951. This is the best showing for any corresponding span in railway history but the increase over 1951 was confined to agricultural products, principally grain.
