MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA

Canadian railways moved a record volume of revenue freight for the month of September when 14,321,754 tons were reported compared with 13,131,983 tons in the previous September and 13,337,154 tons in the same month of 1951. The advance over 1951 was thus 9.1 p.c. or 1,189,771 tons based on good gains in grains, fuels, building products, lumber, newsprint and other manufactures.

Domestic loadings were encouraging at 11,133,099 tons up 11.1 p.c. from 10,016,100 tons one year earlier. Imports from Canadian stations increased from 1,819,925 to 1,898,936 tons but intrasit freight was slightly lower at 1,289,719 tons against 1,295,958 tons in the previous September.

A record volume of freight was carried during the first nine months of 1952 when the total reached 120,117,690 tons or 2,202,872 tons above the corresponding span of 1951 with agricultural products responsible for the advance as other groups were all lower. The gain in the total for agricultural items was 5,196,069 tons or 24 p.c. Forest products posted the widest percentage decline dropping 1,018,430 tons to 15,313,537 tons with pulpwood and lumber off sharply from 1951 levels.

A comparison with total freight carried during the preceding September shows agricultural products increasing 564,577 tons to 3,132,984 with wheat, oats, barley, rye, flaxseed, flour, other mill products, cotton, fruit, and potatoes much heavier. The majority of the Animals and Animal Products commodities continued under 1951 with only hogs, hides and leather and other animal products improved. Larger movements of coal, coke, iron ore, sand and gravel, stone and asphalt moved the Mine Products total up from 5,064,771 tons in September of 1951 to 5,428,170 tons. Forest items in total registered a minor gain of 21,403 tons to aggregate 1,528,526 tons for the month. Logs, posts, ties and gains in lumber and plywood offset the recession in pulpwood deliveries. Continued heavy demand for gasoline and petroleum products, cement, automobiles, beverages, newsprint, canned goods and other manufactures produced an increase of 268,211 tons or 7 p.c. in the Manufactures and Miscellaneous group.

Provincial loadings during September show the majority of provinces reporting improvement over the same period of 1951. Newfoundland had 154,846 tons up from 130,820 with forest items and manufactures and miscellaneous better. The sharp drop in pulpwood shipments from Prince Edward Island discounted a gain in agriculture and the regional total was off from 19,142 to 9,522 tons. Nova Scotia registered a minor gain from 820,121 to 827,302 tons with forest and manufactured items higher. New Brunswick forest output was lighter and despite gains in other groups the provincial aggregate shrank 42,558 tons to 334,038 tons compared with 376,866 tons a year earlier. The Quebec provincial total was nearly equalled at 1,712,943 tons against 1,719,892 in September of 1951. Agricultural and animal items were better as well as mine and manufactured but forest commodities decreased over 69,000 tons. The province of Ontario with an impressive 3,801,448 tons posted an advance of 488,976 tons or 15 p.c. over the previous September with all groups except animals higher.

The advances in western Canada were widespread as a near record crop began its movement to market. The Manitoba total climbed from 705,171 to 849,052 tons and featured a splendid increase in mine products. The Saskatchewan aggregate at 1,285,035 tons was 133,207 tons above September 1951 with wheat and other grains much heavier. Alberta reported 1,206,172 tons loaded, an advance of 232,190 tons or 24 p.c. with agricultural items and manufactures leading. In British Columbia a total of 952,471 tons of revenue freight were loaded for a gain of over 18 p.c. from the previous September. All commodity groups were better in the month under review.

Over 36 p.c. of all freight terminated during September was delivered to foreign connections. The volume of rail freight is the economic pulse of the nation. Canada moves more freight now in one month than was handled in a year less than 70 years ago.
