MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA

In October a total of 14,211,880 tons of revenue freight received rail movement in Canada. This represented a decrease of 825,807 tons or 5.5 p.c. from the 15,037,487 tons hauled during the previous October. Loadings at Canadian stations were 10,972,596 tons, freight received from foreign connections for Canadian points totalled 1,849,743 tons and 1,389,741 tons of intransit freight was moved during the month.

Ten month totals show 131,754,915 tons moved to October 31, 1955 down 3,420,262 tons from the 1952 period. Mine products, notably coal and coke and forest products led by pulpwood accounted for most of the decrease while wheat, sand and gravel, and automobiles and parts were the commodities showing the greatest increases in volume moved during the ten month period.

October freight reports show greatly reduced movements of wheat and barley which more than offset a good gain in oats and led to a drop of 306,086 tons in agricultural products at 3,124,048 tons. Animals and animal products were up 17,196 tons to 179,292 for the month with dressed meats and poultry accounting for the increase. Sand and gravel hauled was up almost 300,000 tons and, together with larger amounts of iron ores and "other" ores, held the reduction in haulage of mine products to 20,640 tons, there being 5,722,530 tons moved in the month. Coal and coke were shipped in sharply reduced volume. All forest products except plywood moved in smaller amounts and the total for the group was down 157,197 tons to 1,198,519 tons. Most commodity classes in the Manufactures and miscellaneous products group were hauled in lesser amounts the total for the group being down 358,881 tons to 3,987,491 during the currently reported month.

New Brunswick, Manitoba and Saskatchewan were the only provinces in which more freight was moved during October, 1955 than one year earlier. Greater loadings of all except animal and mine products accounted for the net increase in New Brunswick. In Manitoba loadings of agricultural and mine products offset other reductions in movement of goods while the Saskatchewan improvement occurred in loadings of agricultural products and manufactures and miscellaneous. Loadings of agricultural products were much smaller in Ontario, Alberta and British Columbia. Ontario also recorded a drop in loadings of animal products and forest products and in receipts from connections. Mine products accounted for the Nova Scotia decrease while forest products and manufactures together with smaller receipts from connections were responsible for the drop in Quebec. Alberta recorded a good gain in loadings of mine products but in British Columbia both this group and the forest products group were loaded in reduced volume.
