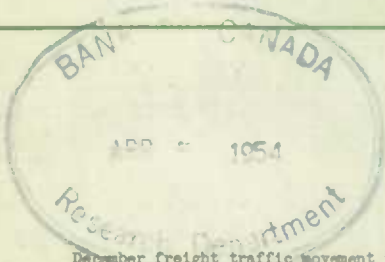

MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA  
DECEMBER, 1953

December freight traffic movement totalled 11,530,974 tons, 1,449,280 lower than that in December, 1952 when 12,980,254 tons were hauled in Canada. Loadings amounted to 9,028,772 tons compared with 10,138,708. Freight received from foreign connections was 1,299,824 tons for delivery in Canada and 1,202,378 tons intransit through Canada. In December 1952 these items were 1,510,946 and 1,330,600 tons respectively. Loadings were thus down 10.9 p.c., imports 14.0 p.c. and intransit freight 9.6 p.c. from 1952.

Agricultural, mine, forest and manufactured and miscellaneous products all showed reduced totals while animals and animal products had a very small gain. Wheat, barley, other mill products and miscellaneous agricultural products were the main factors in a drop of 436,937 tons of agricultural products hauled to 2,895,303 for the month. A good gain in dressed meats and poultry helped bring the animal products total up 7,015 to 170,411 tons in December, 1953. All mine products except sand and gravel and asphalt were down in volume, the total for the group being 359,820 tons lower at 3,755,021. Miscellaneous forest products were moved in larger quantities but all other products in the group were off with the total down 283,866 tons to 1,088,740. Cement, newsprint paper and paperboard etc. showed improved movement but the total for the manufactures and miscellaneous group was down 375,672 tons to 3,621,499 for the month.

Provincial tabulations indicate a general decline in loadings across the country with a small gain in Prince Edward Island and Saskatchewan loadings up from 1,397,169 to 1,458,336 tons. Mine products accounted for the declines in Newfoundland and Manitoba and agricultural products for those in Prince Edward Island and Quebec. Mine products and manufactures were lower in Nova Scotia but forest products gained slightly. All groups were loaded in lesser volume in New Brunswick and Ontario and all but forest products in Alberta and animal products in British Columbia were down. All provinces had smaller receipts from foreign connections.

Totals for Canada for the year 1953 give a preliminary figure of 156,107,052 tons receiving movement in the twelve month period compared with 161,905,537 tons in 1952. This represents a decrease of 5,798,485 tons or 3.6 p.c. The report "Summary of Monthly Traffic Reports, 1953" to be issued at a later date will provide a detailed analysis of 1953 freight traffic movement.
