MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA

JUNE, 1953

A new record for June was reported in revenue freight given transport by Canadian railways when 14,372,450 tons were carried for a gain of 899,616 tons or 6.7 p.c. over June of 1952. The current peak compares with 13,933,405 tons for the same month of 1951, the previous high for the period, and is some 1,271,000 tons above the June, 1943 total.

Loadings at Canadian stations amounted to 11,189,210 tons against 10,614,826 tons in June a year earlier with good advances in agricultural items, mine products and the manufactures group. Intransit freight posted a noteworthy increase from 1,119,661 to 1,413,625 tons while import freight was slightly higher at 1,769,615 versus 1,738,347 tons for the preceding June. All class groups were greater for intransit traffic as June, 1952 was affected by strikes in the United States.

Domestic commodities loaded in better volume this June included wheat up from 1,676,301 to 2,189,535 tons, corn, flaxseed, apples and potatoes. Wool was much heavier, up from 715 to 1,412 tons. Livestock shipments posted a minor gain. Iron ores rose from 309,958 to 342,311 tons and copper, other ores and crude petroleum were also higher. Primary building items joined in the advance. Among manufactured commodities, gasoline, cement up 58,992 tons to 197,809, furniture, fertilizers, paperboards, woodpulp and miscellaneous manufactures were heavier. The wider declines occurred in oats off from 369,149 to 233,825 tons and in rye, other fruit, hogs, dressed meats and dairy products. Fuels totalled somewhat lower. Asphalt was off from 107,276 to 84,901 tons. Forest items in toto were down over 60,000 tons to 1,419,012 as all items except lumber and plywood were reduced. Lumber shipments increased by 46,600 tons to 590,832 tons. Manufactured commodities appreciably lower this June included pig iron down from 79,286 to 33,851 tons, rails, brick, agricultural implements, beverages, newspaper off 16,474 tons to 281,650, fish and L.C.L. at 176,024 tons against 196,944 tons a year earlier.

Increases in provincial loadings in Ontario, Saskatchewan, British Columbia and Newfoundland accounted for the advance over the preceding June. The Newfoundland total moved up from 158,964 to 181,494 tons with all commodity groups higher. Prince Edward Island, loading considerably less pulpwood, shrank to 13,659 from 17,007 tons. Nova Scotia with mine and forest items lower decreased 23,473 to 809,054 tons. Similarly, New Brunswick despite better agricultural deliveries dropped 14,385 tons to 306,681. The Quebec aggregate of 1,669,692 was only 28,303 tons under June of 1952. Forest output was advanced. Ontario posted an encouraging gain of 243,792 tons to total 3,876,518 tons with farm and mine output improved. The Manitoba summary reveals a decrease of 22,245 tons with only manufactures better this June. Saskatchewan, on the strength of heavier grain shipments, advanced from 1,289,353 to 1,638,036 tons to supply almost as much rail freight as the province of Quebec. The Alberta total was well maintained at 1,103,513 tons off only 229 tons from June of 1952. Mine and manufactured items increased. In British Columbia economic activity continues encouraging and 911,272 tons were loaded compared with 859,910 a year ago, a gain of 51,362 tons or 6 p.c. Mine, forest and manufactured items were greater. Lumber rose from 226,515 to 251,815 tons and fertilizers were up 11,323 tons to 43,979.

The cumulative total for all freight, domestic and foreign, carried during the first half of the current year was 75,865,231 tons against 78,322,044 tons to the end of June last year, a decrease of 2,456,813 tons or just over 3 p.c. Sizeable declines in coal, coke, logs, pulpwood, pig iron and L.C.L. have offset gains in wheat, iron ores, stone, lumber, gasoline, petroleum oils, cement, automobiles and miscellaneous manufactures.
