MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA

JULY, 1953

The month of July saw a revenue freight movement of 14,201,657 tons in Canada compared with 14,028,369 tons one year ago. This represented a gain of 173,288 tons or 1.2 p.c. and helped bring the cumulative total for the first seven months of 1953 somewhat closer to that of the same period of 1952. Tons transported to July 31, 1953 totalled 90,066,888 and to the same date in 1952 were 92,350,413 tons.

July loadings at Canadian stations were slightly lower at 10,895,203 tons against 11,238,765 one year ago. In the one year interval loadings of agricultural, animal, forest and manufactured and miscellaneous products were down while those of mine products were slightly higher. Imports during the current July amounted to 1,821,163 tons, a gain of 101,593 over the 1,719,570 received as imports in July, 1952. Intransit goods moved in much greater volume, being 1,485,291 tons in July, 1953 compared with 1,070,034 tons twelve months previously when a steel strike in the United States had affected this traffic.

Commodities loaded in greater quantities during the current July included wheat up from 1,853,381 tons to 1,904,992, corn up almost 20,000 tons to 28,647 flaxseed, potatoes 3,295 tons higher at 11,330, cattle and calves, anthracite coal at 1,508 tons compared with 427, copper ore and concentrates, other ores and concentrates at 470,602 tons against 402,954 and sand and gravel 153,761 tons higher at 770,250 tons. Also loaded in larger amounts were stone, crude petroleum, miscellaneous mine products, lumber, etc., plywood at 20,026 tons compared with 8,743, petroleum products, cement from 151,191 to 192,460 tons automobiles, etc., up from 39,829 to 56,932 tons and woodpulp.

Commodities which were loaded in considerably smaller amounts included oats down from 394,753 tons to 280,379, barley off 65,660 tons to 331,936, bituminous coal 71,682 lower at 629,623 tons, sub-bituminous coal down 34,162 tons to 64,790, iron ores and concentrates down from 514,637 to 341,475 tons and asphalt down 25,413 tons to 98,139. Sharply reduced loadings of logs, etc. from 140,631 to 112,744 and pulpwood from 811,346 to 629,764 tons lowered the total movement of forest products from 1,542,645 to 1,381,244 tons. Iron, pig and bloom loadings dropped from 71,506 to 26,601 tons, newsprint paper from 293,812 to 271,761 tons and the miscellaneous group from 757,820 to 724,882 tons.

Loadings in Newfoundland and Nova Scotia were slightly lower than one year earlier. Prince Edward Island loadings fell from 9,861 to 5,929 tons; those of New Brunswick from 321,165 to 272,953; of Quebec from 1,804,935 to 1,602,754; of Ontario from 3,958,609 to 3,843,227; of Manitoba from 683,881 to 648,390 and Alberta from 1,247,921 to 1,164,134 tons. Saskatchewan loadings rose from 1,365,838 tons to 1,490,018 and those in British Columbia from 800,820 to 825,153 tons. Receipts from connections were higher in Quebec, Ontario, Manitoba and Saskatchewan, while British Columbia, Nova Scotia, New Brunswick and Alberta had reduced tonnage of foreign freight received.
