SEPTEMBER, 1953

Revenue freight carried by Canadian railways during September amounted to 14,014,712 tons, a decrease of 307,042 tons or 2.1 p.c. from the same month of 1952 but 573,277 tons above August 1953 when the total was 13,441,435 tons.

Loadings at stations in Canada at 10,847,707 tons were down 2.6 p.c. from the 11,133,099 tons loaded in September 1952. Imports destined to Canadian points moved in smaller volume at 1,797,162 tons compared with 1,898,936 tons a year previously but intransit freight was up from 1,289,719 to 1,369,853 tons in the comparison.

Freight carried in the nine-month period to the end of September totalled 117,523,035 tons a decrease of 2,594,655 tons from the like period of 1952. Chief source of the drop in tonnage was the forest products group which was off 2,604,138 tons or 17 p.c. to 12,709,399. Gains in the agricultural, animal and manufactured and miscellaneous products groups were offset by a drop in the movement of mine products.

In September agricultural products moved totalled 2,838,761 tons, some 294,233 below the September, 1952 movement with wheat, flour and other mill products down sharply and oats and barley well above the previous September total. Dressed meats and poultry led a gain of 25,965 tons in animals and animal products to 156,251 for the month. In the mine products group anthracite, bituminous and sub-bituminous coal, coke and stone were moved in smaller amounts but good increases in tonnage of lignite coal, iron ores and concentrates, sand and gravel, crude petroleum and miscellaneous mine products brought a gain of 99,100 tons in the group to 5,527,270 tons during September. Logs and pulpwood led a drop in forest products of 50,438 tons to 1,478,088 tons for the month. The manufactures and miscellaneous products group had a decline of 87,436 tons shipped, the group total for the currently reported month being 4,014,352 tons. Leading causes of this reduced movement were lower tonnages of pig and bloom iron, bar, etc. iron and steel and fertilizers while the main offsetting factor was cement which gained considerably.

Provincial data shows that only in Nova Scotia, Alberta and British Columbia was there an improved movement of freight over the previous September. The Nova Scotia gain was due to a good increase in mine products shipped; the Alberta rise was general in all groups except forest products while that in British Columbia occurred in the mine and forest products groups. The reduced movement in Manitoba, Ontario and Quebec was spread through all groups with the exception of a small gain in animals and animal products in Ontario and Manitoba.

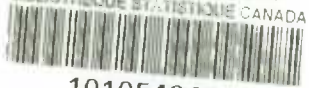
