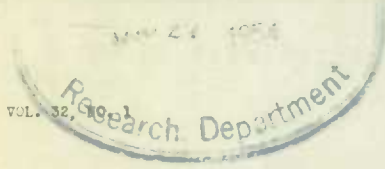

## RAILWAY FREIGHT TRAFFIC

1 This publication presents statistics of the tonnage of revenue freight traffic carried by railways in Canada on the basis of reports provided monthly by 26 companies. The reports are prepared by the reporting companies using as a basis the "Canadian Freight Commodity Statistics Classification" which was instituted with effect January 1, 1954. This classification was designed to provide, for the first time, a freight commodity listing giving proper consideration to railway freight moved in Canada. As a result of the adoption of the new classification the 78 commodities listed previously in this report under the title "Monthly Traffic Report of Railways of Canada" have now been expanded to include 90 commodities. Consequently it is impossible to compare the majority of commodities listed in the current report with past experience. In those cases where comparison is possible the increase or decrease over January, 1953 tonnage has been shown on pages 2 and 3. Another change instituted has been to remove L.C.L. freight from the "Manufactures and Miscellaneous" group and to set it out as a separate group. This now makes it possible to show the total tons weight of commodities moving in carload lots as a sub-total.

2 Total tonnage moved by railways during January was 10,151,582 tons down 16.3 p.c. from January, 1953 when 12,129,942 tons were hauled. Loadings fell 1,574,572 or 17 p.c. to 7,679,308 tons in the currently reported month. Receipts from foreign connections were also lower with freight destined for delivery in Canada down from 1,515,915 to 1,267,771 tons and intransit shipments down from 1,560,147 to 1,204,503 tons.

3 Loadings were down in all provinces except Prince Edward Island and Manitoba, up 4,170 and 10,167 tons to 32,940 and 319,360 tons respectively. Greatest drops in loadings occurred in Ontario and Saskatchewan with a reduction of 414,062 to 2,457,127 tons in the former and of 423,619 to 968,109 tons in the latter. The drop in Ontario was quite general but that in Saskatchewan was almost entirely due to reduced grain shipments, especially of wheat. Receipts from foreign connections were smaller in all provinces, the decline being greatest in Ontario where this item fell from 2,072,672 tons in January, 1953 to 1,825,641 in January, 1954.

4 In the following table comparison between the currently reported month and previous months has been given by provinces and by products (major commodity groups). It must be noted that totals given in the commodity groups for the current report are not absolutely comparable with those for previous months due to the inception of the Canadian Commodity classification mentioned above. This new classification moved certain minor commodities between major groups and hence destroyed direct comparability, however, these changes, being small, still permit a general comparison to be made.
