## RAILWAY FREIGHT TRAFFIC

Month

During November 1954, total freight originated amounted to 14,068,550 tons, up 8.5 p.c. from 12,967,093 for the same month in 1953. Included in the 1954 total are 513,513 tons of iron ore and concentrates hauled by the Quebec North Shore and Labrador Railway. Of the freight originated, 11,074,274 tons was loaded at stations in Canada against 10,111,187 in 1953; 1,666,494 tons were received from foreign connections and destined to Canadian points, up from 1,586,486; and intransit freight totaled 1,327,782 as compared with 1,269,420 one year earlier.

For commodities comparable with those reported for 1953, the following show the principal changes from November 1953 data: wheat dropped 216,052 tons to 1,100,654; oats fell 48,585 tons to 252,685; barley dropped 51,813 tons to 289,028; flaxseed shipments rose 41,793 tons to 94,690; anthracite coal increased 48,065 tons to 329,037; bituminous coal increased 67,056 tons to 1,560,324 and iron and steel (bar, pipe, etc.) dropped 44,666 tons to 172,256.

Freight originated showed increases in tonnage in most provinces with a rise of 38.7 p.c. to 2,874,660 tons in Quebec and of 29.2 p.c. to 437,100 tons in New Brunswick.

Cumulative

During the first eleven months of 1954, a total of 133,168,976 tons of freight was carried, a decrease of 7.9 p.c. from 144,576,078 for the like period of 1953.

Most significant reductions for commodities comparable with the 1953 data are: wheat, down 6,773,549 tons or 39.9 p.c. to 10,200,187; oats, down 685,471 tons to 2,315,708; barley, down 748,405 tons to 3,083,343; iron and steel (bar, pipe, etc.), down 1,082,058 tons to 2,112,911; and L.C.L., freight down 471,828 tons to 2,046,280.
