RAILWAY FREIGHT TRAFFIC

The present report contains two principal changes from those previously published in this series. First the water-borne imports at lake and ocean ports have been separated from the rail imports and are now included with the commodities "Loaded at Stations in Canada". This permits a thorough analysis of traffic entering the country by rail subdivided between goods destined to points in Canada and intransit shipments in route to foreign points by rail. A similar treatment of terminated traffic permits study of rail exports to the United States. The second change results from the adoption of the "Uniform Classification of Accounts for Common Carriers by Railway". The Classification groups railways into four classes and it has been decided that, for the purpose of Traffic, Operating and Carloading Statistics on a more frequent than annual basis, all railways having gross annual revenues of \$500,000 or more (class 1 and 11 carriers) shall be included in each series. The change has been made in order that the monthly statistics of freight traffic and railway operations and those for carloadings will be more comparable. It has not been possible to make comparisons between these series in the past due to the fact that different groups of railways were included in each series.

A comparative table is presented below showing the effect of the change in the companies reporting. Statistics for 1955 covered the operations of 28 railways, 8 of which were lines having annual revenues of less than \$500,000. These lines were:

The Cumberland Railway and Coal Co.	The Canada and Gulf Terminal
London and Port Stanley Railway Co.	Central Vermont Railway Inc.
Morrissey Fernie & Michel Railway Co.	Greater Winnipeg Water District
Ottawa and New York Railway Co. (New York Central)	Maritime Coal Railway & Power Co.

One railway has been added to the list, namely The White Pass and Yukon Route (Lines in Canada). The table gives a comparison between 28 and 20 railways for January, 1955 and 21 and 20 railways for January, 1956. It shows that the effect of the change is very slight and that the eight firms deleted carried 109,526 tons of freight or less than 1 p.c. of the total reported in January, 1955. The principal commodity group affected is "mine products" due to the extraction of the bituminous coal hauled by the Cumberland Railway and Coal Co., and Morrissey, Fernie and Michel Railway Co.
