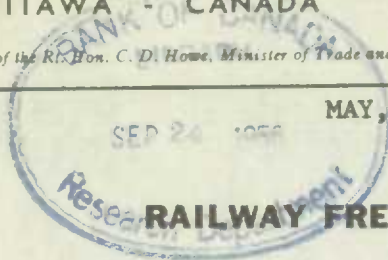

## RAILWAY FREIGHT TRAFFIC

Since January 1, 1956 these reports have not been comparable with those for previous years due to two principal changes. The first change is that water-borne imports at lake or ocean ports formerly included with rail imports as "Receipts from Foreign Connections" are now included with the commodities "Loaded at Stations in Canada." This change now permits a thorough analysis of freight entering the country by rail, subdivided between goods destined to Canadian points and intransit freight en route to foreign points by rail. A similar treatment of freight terminated permits study of rail exports to the United States. The second major change is the adoption of the "Uniform Classification of Accounts for Common Carriers by Railway," which groups railways into four classes. All railways having gross annual revenues of \$500,000 or more (class 1 and 11 carriers) are now required to report monthly and weekly statistics of their operations. Data for Railway Freight Traffic, Railway Operating and Carloading statistics will be more comparable as a result. It has not been possible in the past to make comparisons between these statistical series due to the fact that different groups of railways were included in each.

A comparative table is presented below showing the effect of the change in the companies reporting. Eight companies which had annual revenues of less than \$500,000 were deleted from statistics for 1955, and one company was added for 1956. The table gives comparisons between 28 and 20 railways in May, 1955 and for 21 and 20 railways in May, 1956. It shows that the effect of the change is very slight and that the eight companies deleted carried only 159,645 tons of freight or less than 1 per cent of the total reported for May, 1955. Mine products was the principal commodity affected by the change because of the extraction of bituminous coal hauled by the Cumberland Railway and Coal Co. and the Morrissey, Fernie and Michel Railway Co.
