RAILWAY FREIGHT TRAFFIC

On January 1, 1956 the monthly Freight Traffic Statistical series underwent two principal changes. First the water-borne imports at lake or ocean ports formerly included together with rail imports as "Receipts from Foreign Connections" are now included with commodities "Loaded at Stations in Canada". This change now makes possible an analysis of traffic entering the country by rail subdivided between goods destined to Canadian points and intransit freight en route to Foreign points by rail. A similar treatment of freight terminated permits study of rail exports to the United States. The second change results from the adoption of the "Uniform Classification of Accounts for Common Carriers by Railway". The classification groups railways into four classes and all railways having gross annual revenues of \$500,000 or more (class I and II common carriers) are now required to report monthly and weekly statistics. Data for Freight Traffic, Railway Operating and Carloading statistics will be more comparable. It has not been possible in the past to make comparisons between these series due to the different groups of railways used in each.

A table is presented below showing the effect of the change in the companies reporting. Eight companies which had annual revenues of less than \$500,000 in 1955 were deleted and one company was added in 1956. The table gives comparisons between 28 and 20 railways for July, 1955 and for 21 and 20 railways for July, 1956. The effect of the change is very slight and shows that the eight companies deleted carried only 171,720 tons of freight or just over 1 per cent of the total reported for July 1955. Mine Products is the principal commodity affected by the change due to the extraction of bituminous coal hauled by the Cumberland Railway and Coal Co., and the Morrissey, Fernie and Michel Railway Company.
