## RAILWAY FREIGHT TRAFFIC

Monthly Freight Traffic Statistics reports for 1956 are not comparable to those for previous years due to two principal changes. First, water-borne imports at lake or ocean ports have been separated from rail imports and are now included with the commodities "Loaded at Stations in Canada". This change now makes possible a thorough analysis of traffic entering the country by rail, subdivided between goods destined to points in Canada and intransit freight shipped to foreign points by rail. A similar treatment of freight terminated permits study of rail exports to the United States. The second change is the adoption of the "Uniform Classification of Accounts for Common Carriers by Railway," which groups railways into four classes. All railways having gross annual revenues of \$500,000 or more (class I and II carriers) are now required to report monthly and weekly statistics. Monthly statistics of freight traffic and railway operations and those for carloadings will be more comparable as a result. Comparisons between these statistical series were not possible in the past due to the different groups of railways included in each.

The table below shows the result of the change in the companies reporting. Eight companies which had annual revenues of less than \$500,000 in 1955 were deleted in 1956, and one company was added. The table gives comparisons between 28 and 20 railways for September, 1955, and for 21 and 20 railways for September, 1956. The effect of the change is very slight and shows that the eight companies deleted carried only 191,619 tons of freight, or just over one per cent of the total reported for September, 1955. The principal commodity group affected is "mine products" due to the deletion of bituminous coal hauled by the Cumberland Railway and Coal Co. and the Morrissey, Fernie and Michel Railway Company.
