## RAILWAY FREIGHT TRAFFIC

November, 1958

Presented in this report are revenue freight traffic statistics of class 1 and 2 railways operating in Canada. The British Columbia Electric Railway, which reported for the first time in January 1958, is not included in the comparable 1957 data. As of January 1, 1958 the Hudson Bay Railway was absorbed into the Canadian National System.

During the month of November 12,110,870 tons of revenue freight were loaded in Canada and received from United States rail connections, a decline of 14.6 per cent from 14,178,904 tons handled in the same month one year earlier. Of the November 1958 total, 10,218,229 tons were loaded at points in Canada (including imports at lake or ocean ports) in contrast to 11,902,640 tons loaded in 1957. Freight received from United States rail connections destined to points in Canada totalled 818,956 tons as compared with 1,076,868 and intransit freight (United States to United States through Canada) amounted to 1,073,685 tons as against 1,199,396 in the previous year.

Products of mines loaded in Canada during November totalled 3,834,542 tons, down 1,477,756 from 5,312,298 tons a year earlier. Bituminous coal with 1,034,487 tons was the principal mine product handled in the 1958 month while iron ore was the main commodity moved in 1957 with 1,574,154 tons. Manufactures and miscellaneous movements declined to 2,856,426 tons from 2,978,582 with fuel oil being the main commodity carried in both years. Products of agriculture loaded in Canada fell slightly during November to 2,373,612 tons from 2,378,307 with loadings of wheat aggregating 1,162,324 tons in the current year and 952,481 tons a year ago. Products of forests declined to 934,697 tons from 944,464 and the volume of animals and products carried fell to 114,982 tons from 143,524. Less than carload freight (l.c.l.) movements dropped to 103,970 tons from 145,465.

In a provincial breakdown of freight loaded during November, eight of the ten provinces show declines in the volume of freight carried when compared with the previous year. The greatest decreases occurred in Quebec and Prince Edward Island where tonnages fell 31.4 and 24.5 per cent, respectively. Loadings in Newfoundland rose 12.7 per cent to 129,276 tons from 114,731 and in British Columbia 7.5 per cent to 879,091 tons from 817,590.

During the month of November 12,123,291 tons of revenue freight terminated on railway lines in Canada. Of this total, 9,875,977 tons were unloaded at Canadian points (including deliveries to water carriers) and 2,247,314 tons were delivered to United States rail connections. This compares with 14,232,841 tons terminated in November 1957 of which 11,807,164 tons were unloaded in Canada and 2,425,677 tons were delivered to United States rail connections.

For the first eleven months of 1958 a total of 140,874,282 tons of freight was loaded in Canada and received from United States rail connections. This compares with 160,790,134 tons in the previous year.
