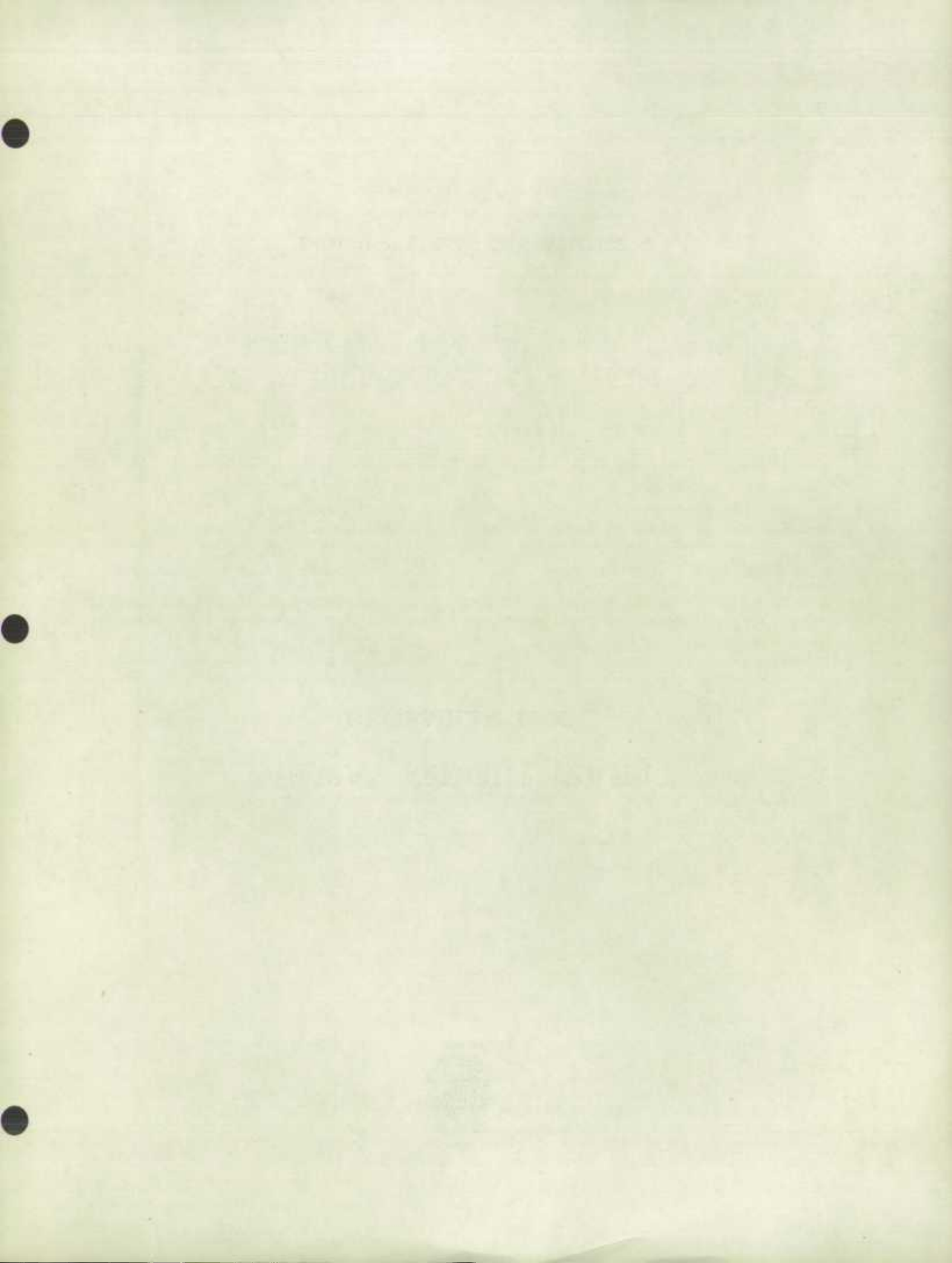

## RAILWAY FREIGHT TRAFFIC

December, 1959

Presented in this report are revenue freight traffic statistics of twenty-two class 1 and 2 railways operating in Canada, (the C.N.R., C.P.R. and other carriers having gross annual revenues of \$500,000 or more).

During the month of December, revenue freight loaded in Canada and received from United States rail connections totalled 12,136,430 tons, an increase of 8.6 per cent from 11,177,099 tons in December 1958. During the month under review, 9,992,871 tons were loaded on lines in Canada (including imports at lake or ocean ports) in contrast to 9,144,671 tons in the previous year. Freight received from United States rail connections destined to points in Canada totalled 857,711 tons as compared with 841,865 and intransit freight (United States to United States through Canada) amounted to 1,285,848 tons as opposed to 1,190,563 in December 1958.

Forest products loaded by railways in Canada during December totalled 1,152,929 tons as compared with 964,184 tons a year earlier. Products of mines rose to 3,464,124 tons from 2,993,395, and manufactures and miscellaneous movements increased to 3,165,372 tons from 2,878,208. Animals and products declined to 90,626 tons from 95,072 and products of agriculture were down to 2,041,098 tons from 2,123,836 in 1958. Less than carload freight (l.c.l.) declined to 78,722 tons from 89,976.

A provincial breakdown of revenue freight loaded in Canada showed increases in six of the ten provinces. The greatest of these occurred in Ontario where loadings rose 31.2 per cent to 3,413,293 tons from 2,601,465. Nova Scotia with the second largest increase rose 20.6 per cent to 957,816 tons from 794,167. Saskatchewan reported the largest decline with loadings down 22.4 per cent.

Revenue freight terminated by railways operating in Canada totalled 12,161,612 tons. Of this total 9,200,814 tons were unloaded at Canadian points (including deliveries to water carriers) and 2,960,798 tons were delivered to United States rail connections. This compares with 11,261,245 tons terminated in December 1958 of which 8,752,523 tons were unloaded in Canada and 2,508,722 tons delivered to United States rail connections.

For the twelve month period of 1959 a total of 164,809,587 tons of freight was loaded in Canada and received from United States rail connections in contrast to 152,051,381 tons in the previous year.
