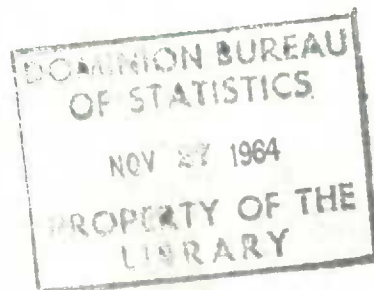

## RAILWAY FREIGHT TRAFFIC

MAY 1964

Presented in this report are revenue freight traffic statistics of twenty-three class 1 and 2 railways operating in Canada, (The C.N.R., C.P.R. and other carriers having average gross revenues of \$500,000 or more annually). Excluded herein are details of class 3 and 4 roads (companies with annual revenues of less than \$500,000) whose traffic represents about one per cent of all common carrier rail movements. Freight interchanged between Canadian railways is not duplicated in this report.

During May 1964, tons of revenue freight loaded on railway lines in Canada and received from United States rail connections totalled 17,219,532, up 8.8 per cent over May 1963. Of this total, tons loaded in Canada (including receipts from water carriers) amounted to 15,134,744, a gain of 9.3 per cent; overhead freight (U.S. to U.S. through Canada) increased to 1,215,204 tons or by 7.4 per cent while 869,584 tons of freight were received from U.S. rail connections destined to points in Canada. The latter represented a 1.5 per cent increase over the previous year.

Revenue freight loadings by commodity groups, showed increased tonnages in four of the six major categories. Products of agriculture were up 39.5 per cent to 2,777,773 tons; mines and products rose 5.0 per cent to 7,206,341 tons; manufactures and miscellaneous increased 4.5 per cent to 3,929,582 tons and forest products were up 2.2 per cent to 1,093,900 tons. Animals and products decreased 1.2 per cent to 59,171 tons and less-than-carload freight (l.c.l.) fell 30.9 per cent to 67,977 tons.

On a regional basis, eight of the ten provinces reported increased freight loadings during the month under review. Alberta tonnages were up 38.0 per cent; Saskatchewan 28.9 per cent; British Columbia 9.3 per cent; New Brunswick 8.6 per cent; Ontario 7.7 per cent; Quebec 4.6 per cent while Prince Edward Island and Nova Scotia each reported increases of 2.9 per cent. Loadings in Newfoundland fell 19.2 per cent and in Manitoba they decreased 14.1 per cent.

Revenue freight terminated on railway lines in Canada during the current month totalled 17,065,914 tons, a gain of 9.2 per cent from the same month last year. Of the May 1964 total, 14,264,006 tons were unloaded at Canadian points (including deliveries to water carriers) and 2,801,908 tons were delivered to U.S. rail connections. This compares with 12,995,728 tons terminated in Canada and 2,630,870 tons delivered to U.S. rail connections in May 1963.

During the first five months of 1964, a total of 74,092,936 tons of revenue freight was loaded in Canada and received from United States rail connections, up 19.7 per cent over the corresponding period of 1963.

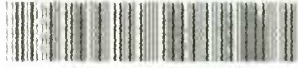
