RAILWAY FREIGHT TRAFFIC

FIRST QUARTER 1966

Beginning with this issue, railway freight traffic data are being published on a quarterly rather than a monthly basis. These statistics were first issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics for the period October 1920, and had continued to appear monthly since that time.

The present publication containing 266 class segregations is based on the Canadian Freight Commodity Statistics Classification adopted January 1, 1957. Current statistics cover the operations of two class I roads (the Canadian National Railways and the Canadian Pacific Railway Company) and twenty-three class II railways (others with gross annual revenues of \$500,000 or more).

Freight statistics of the Quebec North Shore and Labrador Railway, which include movements in both Quebec and Newfoundland, have all been shown in Quebec in the past. Commencing with this report, Quebec North Shore and Labrador traffic data have been compiled and published to reflect a proper distribution to both provinces. This fact should be taken into consideration when making comparisons of current data with that of the previous year for these areas.

During the first quarter of 1966, 47,103,897 tons of revenue freight were loaded by rail in Canada and received from United States rail connections, up 11.9 per cent over the same three month period of 1965. Of the current total, 40,725,210 tons were loaded in Canada (including waterborne imports) an increase of 14.0 per cent; receipts from U.S. rail connections destined to Canada rose 7.3 per cent to 2,736,995 tons. Overhead freight (U.S. to U.S. through Canada) fell 4.4 per cent to 3,641,692 tons.

Revenue freight loaded during January, February and March increased in all six major commodity groups. Products of agriculture increased 27.4 per cent to 6,266,787 tons; forest products gained 13.4 per cent; manufactures and miscellaneous rose 12.8 per cent; mines and products inclined 10.6 per cent and animals and products were up 1.9 per cent. Less-than-carload freight (l.c.l.) tonnages at 247,129 were 29.5 per cent above the previous year period.

On a geographic basis, five of the ten provinces (exclusive of Quebec and Newfoundland because of the reason noted earlier in this text) experienced increased rail loadings during the first three months of 1966. Tonnages in Saskatchewan rose 26.1 per cent; Manitoba 25.1 per cent; Alberta 19.7 per cent; British Columbia 19.0 per cent and Ontario 17.2 per cent. Revenue freight loadings decreased 12.6 per cent in Prince Edward Island; 11.6 per cent in New Brunswick and 0.1 per cent in Nova Scotia.

Revenue freight terminated in Canada during the first quarter of 1966 increased 12.4 per cent to 47,298,513 tons. Of this total, 38,068,418 tons were unloaded in Canada (including deliveries to water lines) and 9,230,095 tons were delivered to U.S. rail connections. This compares with 33,010,623 tons terminated in Canada and 9,082,112 tons delivered to U.S. rail connections in 1965.
