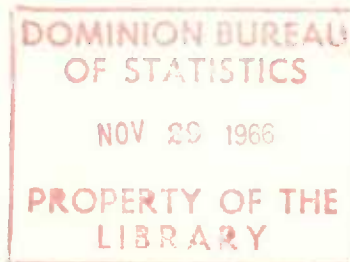

RAILWAY FREIGHT TRAFFIC

SECOND QUARTER 1966

Presented in this report are revenue freight traffic statistics of twenty-five class 1 and 2 railways operating in Canada, (the C.N.R., C.P.R. and other carriers having average gross revenues of \$500,000 or more annually). Excluded are details of class 3 and 4 roads (companies with annual revenues of less than \$500,000) whose traffic represents about one per cent of all rail movements. Freight interchanged between Canadian railways is not duplicated in this publication.

A strike involving some fifty trucking companies in Ontario, which began January 20, ended May 1.

Freight statistics of the Quebec North Shore and Labrador Railway, which include movements in both Quebec and Newfoundland, have all been shown in Quebec in past years. These data are now being compiled and published to reflect the proper distribution to both provinces. This fact should be taken into consideration when making comparisons of current data with that of the previous year for these areas.

During the second quarter of 1966 a total of 57,142,435 tons of revenue freight was loaded by rail in Canada and received from United States rail connections, up 11.5 per cent over the same three month period of 1965. Of the 1966 total, 50,294,051 tons were loaded in Canada (including imports at lake or ocean ports) an increase of 12.9 per cent; receipts from U.S. rail destined to Canada rose 2.0 per cent to 3,072,848 tons. Overhead freight (U.S. to U.S. through Canada) increased 2.0 per cent to 3,775,536 tons.

Rail loadings in Canada during the second quarter registered increases in four of the six major commodity groups. Products of agriculture rose 43.4 per cent to 8,147,325 tons, largely because of heavier wheat shipments. Products of forests were up 14.9 per cent to 4,565,376 tons; manufactures and miscellaneous increased 12.6 per cent to 14,097,924 tons and products of mines gained 5.1 per cent to 23,042,186 tons, animals and products declined 1.6 per cent to 189,369 tons and merchandise l.c.l. dropped 0.1 per cent to 251,871 tons.

On a provincial basis, seven of the ten provinces (exclusive of Quebec and Newfoundland because of the reason noted earlier in this text) reported increased loadings during the second quarter of 1966. Tonnages in Saskatchewan rose 60.6 per cent; Manitoba 34.7 per cent; Alberta 13.2 per cent; British Columbia 10.8 per cent; Ontario 5.0 per cent; Nova Scotia 1.6 per cent and New Brunswick 0.8 per cent. Prince Edward Island loadings declined 18.5 per cent.

Revenue freight terminated in Canada during the second quarter of 1966 increased 11.9 per cent to 57,298,849 tons. Of this total 47,212,596 tons were unloaded in Canada (including deliveries to water lines) and 10,086,253 tons were delivered to U.S. rail connections. This compares with 42,524,378 tons terminated in Canada and 8,670,219 tons delivered to U.S. rail connections in 1965.

During the first half of 1966, a total of 104,246,332 tons of revenue freight was loaded in Canada and received from U.S. rail connections, up 11.7 per cent from the similar 1965 period.

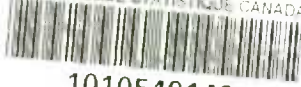
