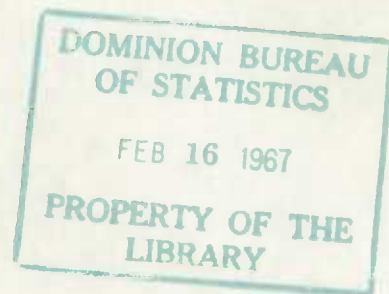

RAILWAY FREIGHT TRAFFIC

THIRD QUARTER 1966

Presented herein are revenue freight traffic statistics of twenty-five class 1 and 2 railways operating in Canada, (the C.N.R., C.P.R. and other carriers having average gross revenues of \$500,000 or more annually). Excluded are details of class 3 and 4 roads (companies with annual revenues of less than \$500,000) whose traffic represents about one per cent of all rail movements. Freight interchanged between Canadian railways is not duplicated in this publication.

Freight statistics of the Quebec North Shore and Labrador Railway, which include movements in both Quebec and Newfoundland, have all been shown in Quebec since November 1964. Beginning in 1966 the data for each of these provinces is being reported and published separately to reflect the proper geographic distribution. In the quarter under review, 1.7 million tons or 30 per cent of Q.N.S.L. loadings took place in Newfoundland, while 89,000 tons or less than two per cent of the freight unloaded occurred in that province.

Traffic originating and terminating in the Northwest Territories has been included with statistics for Alberta since such movements began on a regular basis in late 1964. Commencing with this report, data relative to the N.W.T. is excluded from Alberta and Canada totals but are not shown elsewhere in tabular form due to lack of columnar space in the present format. During the third quarter of 1966, 181,787 tons of revenue freight were loaded in the N.W.T. with lead ore and concentrates accounting for 42.3 per cent of this amount and zinc ore and concentrates making up the remainder.

Factors contributing to the overall third quarter decline in rail freight movements included strikes in July by machinists and iron workers in Northeastern Quebec; walkouts in early August by express-freight handlers in Toronto and Montreal; a nation-wide rail strike which affected almost all lines in Canada between August 26 and September 2; and a strike against the Pacific Great Eastern Railway in British Columbia during part of September.

During the three-month period a total of 54,218,551 tons of revenue freight was loaded by rail in Canada and received from United States rail connections, down 3.6 per cent over the same period of 1965. Of the 1966 total, 48,276,501 tons were loaded in Canada (including imports at lake or ocean ports) a decline of 3.8 per cent and receipts from U.S. rail destined to Canada fell 6.4 per cent to 2,677,916 tons. Overhead freight (U.S. to U.S. through Canada) rose 2.3 per cent to 3,264,134 tons.

Rail loadings in Canada during the quarter under review registered declines in three of the six major commodity groups. Animals and products dropped 12.1 per cent to 165,558 tons; mines and products were down 11.5 per cent to 22,855,018 tons and l.c.l. freight fell 44.5 per cent to 205,156 tons. Continued high volume exports of wheat contributed to an increase of 16.3 per cent in movements of agricultural products to 8,070,099 tons. Products of forests were up 1.8 per cent to 4,602,305 tons and manufactures and miscellaneous increased 0.3 per cent to 12,378,365.

Geographically, loaded tonnages declined 26.7 per cent in Prince Edward Island; 10.1 per cent in Ontario; 4.7 per cent in Manitoba; 3.8 per cent in Nova Scotia; and 3.0 per cent in British Columbia. Loadings in New Brunswick rose 18.7 per cent, in Saskatchewan 18.3 per cent and in Alberta 2.1 per cent.

Revenue freight terminated in Canada during the third quarter declined 3.6 per cent to 54,364,557 tons. Of this total 45,857,453 tons were unloaded in Canada (including deliveries to water lines) and 8,507,104 tons delivered to U.S. rail connections. This compares with 47,787,907 tons terminated in Canada and 8,583,710 tons delivered to U.S. rail connections in 1965.

During the first nine months of 1966, a total of 158,464,883 tons of revenue freight was loaded in Canada and received from U.S. rail connections, up 5.9 per cent from the similar 1965 period.
