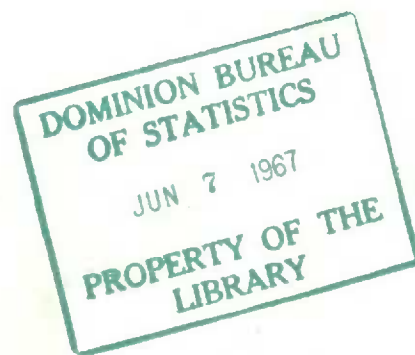

RAILWAY FREIGHT TRAFFIC

FOURTH QUARTER 1966

Presented herein are revenue freight traffic statistics of twenty-five class 1 and 2 railways operating in Canada, (the C.N.R., C.P.R. and other carriers having average gross revenues of \$500,000 or more annually). Excluded are details of class 3 and 4 roads (companies with annual revenues of less than \$500,000) whose traffic represents about one per cent of all rail movements. Freight interchanged between Canadian railways is not duplicated in this publication.

Freight statistics of the Quebec North Shore and Labrador Railway, which include movements in both Quebec and Newfoundland, have all been shown in Quebec in past years. Beginning in 1966 the data for each of these provinces has been reported and published separately to reflect the proper geographic distribution of traffic.

Traffic originating and terminating in the Northwest Territories is excluded from Alberta and Canada totals but are not shown elsewhere in tabular form due to the lack of columnar space in the present format. During the fourth quarter of 1966, 156,405 tons of revenue freight were loaded in the N.W.T. with zinc ore and concentrates accounting for 63.7 per cent of this amount and lead ore and concentrates making up the remainder.

During the three-month period a total of 55,501,935 tons of revenue freight was loaded by rail in Canada and received from United States rail connections, a decline of 0.2 per cent from the same period of 1965. Of the 1966 total, 48,961,586 tons were loaded in Canada (including imports at lake or ocean ports), down 0.9 per cent, and receipts from U.S. rail destined to Canada fell 1.4 per cent to 2,877,729 tons. Overhead freight (U.S. to U.S. through Canada) increased 11.6 per cent to 3,662,620 tons.

Rail loadings in Canada during the fourth quarter registered declines in three of the six major commodity groups. Products of mines declined 2.6 per cent to 22,002,331 tons; manufactures and miscellaneous dropped 1.0 per cent to 13,104,197 tons and l.c.l. freight fell 44.8 per cent to 187,082 tons. Products of forests rose 7.4 per cent to 4,454,623 tons; animals and products were up 2.2 per cent to 259,595 tons and products of agriculture increased 1.0 per cent to 8,953,758 tons.

Geographically, (exclusive of Quebec and Newfoundland) loaded tonnages declined 13.3 per cent in Nova Scotia; 6.3 per cent in British Columbia; 5.8 per cent in Manitoba and 5.3 per cent in Ontario. Loadings in New Brunswick rose 13.8 per cent; Saskatchewan 4.8 per cent; Alberta 4.6 per cent and Prince Edward Island 2.7 per cent.

Revenue freight terminated in Canada during the quarter under review declined 0.2 per cent to 55,627,114 tons. Of this total 46,343,485 tons were unloaded in Canada (including deliveries to water lines) and 9,283,629 tons was delivered to U.S. rail connections. This compares with 46,755,172 tons terminated in Canada and 8,784,534 tons delivered to U.S. rail connections in 1965.

During the year 1966, a total of 213,966,818 tons of revenue freight was loaded in Canada and received from U.S. rail connections, up 4.3 per cent from 1965.
