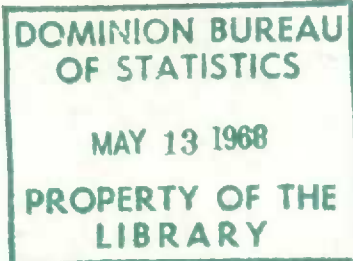

RAILWAY FREIGHT TRAFFIC

FOURTH QUARTER 1967

Presented in this report are revenue freight traffic statistics for twenty-five class 1 and 2 common carrier railways operating in Canada, (the C.N.R., C.P.R. and other companies having average gross revenues of \$500,000 or more annually). Excluded are details of class 3 and 4 roads (companies with annual revenues of less than \$500,000) whose traffic represents about one per cent of all rail movements. Freight interchanged between Canadian railways is not duplicated in this publication.

During the fourth quarter of 1967, 52,512,528 tons of revenue freight were loaded by rail in Canada and received from U.S. rail connections, down 5.7 per cent from the same three month period of 1966. Of the current total 46,927,571 tons were loaded in Canada (including waterborne imports) a decline of 4.5 per cent: receipts from U.S. connections destined to Canada fell 12.1 per cent to 2,528,552 tons and overhead freight (U.S. to U.S. through Canada) dropped 16.6 per cent to 3,056,405 tons.

Revenue freight loaded during the three month period under review declined in four of the six major commodity groups. Products of agriculture dropped 33.3 per cent to 5,968,852 tons due mainly to a 2.9 million ton drop in wheat loadings. Animals and products were down 5.8 per cent to 244,563 tons; products of forests declined 0.9 per cent to 4,415,848 tons and merchandise l.c.l., fell 61.5 per cent to 72,003 tons. Products of mines rose 3.2 per cent to 22,873,286 tons and manufactures and miscellaneous increased 1.9 per cent to 13,353,019 tons.

Geographically, loaded tonnages decreased 27.9 per cent in Saskatchewan; 22.2 per cent in Manitoba; 7.3 per cent in New Brunswick; 6.6 per cent in Alberta and 0.2 per cent in Nova Scotia. Quebec loadings remained almost unchanged. Combined loadings in the Yukon and Northwest Territories rose 13.7 per cent; in Ontario rail traffic rose 3.0 per cent; Newfoundland was up 1.7 per cent; Prince Edward Island and British Columbia increased 1.1 per cent, in each case.

Revenue freight terminated in Canada during the fourth quarter declined 5.6 per cent to 52,538,971 tons. Of this total 43,657,807 tons were unloaded (at points within the provinces which included deliveries to water connections) and 8,881,164 tons were delivered to U.S rail connections. This compares with 46,369,353 tons terminated in Canada and 9,283,629 tons delivered to U.S. rail connections during the same quarter of 1966.

During the year 1967, a total of 209,453,356 tons of revenue freight was loaded in Canada and received from U.S. rail connections, down 2.3 per cent from the previous year.
