

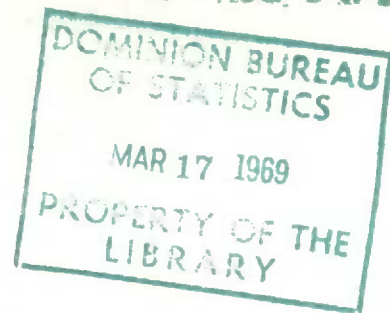

RAILWAY FREIGHT TRAFFIC

THIRD QUARTER 1968

Presented in this report are the revenue freight traffic statistics of twenty-five class 1 and 2 common carrier railways operating in Canada (the C.N.R., C.P. and other companies having average gross revenues of \$500,000 or more annually). Excluded are details of class 3 and 4 roads (companies with annual revenues of less than \$500,000) whose traffic represents about one per cent of all rail movements. Freight interchanged between Canadian railways is not included and therefore not duplicated in this publication.

During the third quarter of 1968, a total of 56,429,149 tons of revenue freight was loaded in Canada and received from United States rail connections, an increase of 2.6 per cent from the same 1967 period. Of the 1968 quarterly total under review 50,908,719 tons were loaded in Canada (including imports at lake or ocean ports) an increase of 2.7 per cent, while receipts from U.S. rail connections destined to Canadian points fell by a similar amount to 2,453,908 tons. Overhead freight (U.S. to U.S. through Canada) rose 5.8 per cent to 3,066,522 tons.

The 2.6 per cent increase in revenue freight loadings during the third quarter was mainly due to heavier shipments in two of the six major commodity groups. Products of mines rose 12.6 per cent to 27,359,745 tons and manufactures and miscellaneous increased 5.1 per cent to 13,669,574 tons. Decreases occurred in the remaining categories as follows: products of agriculture 33.1 per cent; animals and products 10.9 per cent; forest products 0.9 per cent and less-than-carload freight (l.c.l.) 50.6 per cent.

Geographically, loaded tonnages increased 27.5 per cent in Newfoundland; 12.9 per cent in Ontario; 10.1 per cent in the Yukon and Northwest Territories; 9.0 per cent in Nova Scotia; 4.7 per cent in New Brunswick; 1.8 per cent in Quebec and 0.4 per cent in British Columbia. Loadings in Saskatchewan mainly because of declines in wheat movements were down 31.9 per cent; Manitoba registered a decline of 7.1 per cent; Prince Edward Island was down 6.3 per cent and Alberta showed a decrease of 0.3 per cent.

Revenue freight terminated in Canada during the third quarter rose 2.8 per cent to 56,377,140 tons. Of this total 47,293,823 tons were unloaded in Canada (including deliveries to water lines) and 9,083,317 tons were delivered to U.S. rail connections. This compares with 46,315,850 tons terminated in Canada and 8,540,813 tons delivered to U.S. rail connections during the same period of 1967.
