## RAILWAY FREIGHT TRAFFIC

FOURTH QUARTER 1968

Presented herein are revenue freight traffic statistics of twenty-five class 1 and 2 common carrier railways operating in Canada, (the C.N.R., C.P.R. and other companies having average gross revenues of \$500,000 or more annually). Excluded from this report are details of class 3 and 4 roads (companies with annual revenues of less than \$500,000) whose traffic represents about one per cent of all rail operations. Freight interchanged between Canadian railways is not included in this publication.

During the period under review, 55,048,386 tons of revenue freight were loaded in Canada and received from U.S rail connections, up 4.8 per cent from the last quarter of 1967. Of the fourth quarter 1968 total, 49,552,327 tons were loaded in Canada (including imports at lake and ocean ports), a gain of 5.6 per cent; freight received from U.S. rail connections destined to points in Canada increased 4.7 per cent to 2,646,486 tons, while overhead freight (U.S. to U.S. through Canada) fell 6.8 per cent to 2,849,573 tons.

On a commodity basis, increases were reported in five of the six major groups. Products of forests rose 20.8 per cent to 5,333,800 tons; manufactures and miscellaneous gained 7.7 per cent to 14,380,480 tons; products of agriculture increased 6.4 per cent to 6,349,912 tons; less-than-carload freight (l.c.l.) was up 6.0 per cent to 76,300 tons and products of mines rose 1.3 per cent to 23,168,110 tons. Animals and products declined 0.3 per cent to 243,725 tons.

Geographically loaded tonnages increased 22.5 per cent in British Columbia; 21.0 per cent in Newfoundland; 20.6 per cent in Manitoba; 9.2 per cent in the Yukon and Northwest Territories; 5.9 per cent in Ontario; 2.2 per cent in Saskatchewan; and 1.1 per cent in New Brunswick. Decreases occurred in the following provinces: Prince Edward Island 4.9 per cent; Quebec 4.1 per cent; Nova Scotia 1.1 per cent and Alberta 0.4 per cent.

Revenue freight terminating on railway lines in Canada during the fourth quarter of 1968, rose 4.0 per cent to 54,662,300 tons. Of this total, 45,500,187 tons were unloaded in Canada (including deliveries to water lines) and 9,162,113 tons were delivered to U.S. rail connections. This compares with 43,657,807 tons unloaded in Canada and 8,881,164 tons delivered to U.S. rail connections during the latter three months of 1967.

Railway freight tonnages for the year 1968, totalled 215,416,593 tons, an increase of 2.8 per cent over the previous year.
