## RAILWAY FREIGHT TRAFFIC

FIRST QUARTER 1969

Presented herein, are revenue freight traffic statistics for twenty-five class 1 and 2 common carrier railways operating in Canada, (the C.N.R., C.P.R. and other companies having average gross revenues of \$500,000 or more annually). Excluded from this report are details of class 3 and 4 roads (companies with annual revenues of less than \$500,000) whose traffic represents about one per cent of all rail movements. Freight interchanged between Canadian railways is not duplicated in this report.

Revenue freight loaded on railway lines in Canada and received from U.S. rail connections totalled 49,942,179 tons, up 6.3 per cent on the first quarter of 1968. Of the current period total, 43,733,871 tons were loaded in Canada (including imports at lake and ocean ports), an increase of 6.0 per cent; freight received from U. S. rail connections destined to points in Canada rose 17.6 per cent to 3,070,029 tons and overhead freight ( U.S. to U.S. through Canada) increased 1.6 per cent to 3,138,279 tons.

Increases in traffic originated or loaded in Canada were recorded for four of the six major commodity groups. Products of mines rose 9.2 per cent to 18,456,322 tons; forest products increased 7.7 per cent to 5,313,740 tons; manufactures and miscellaneous gained 3.5 per cent to 15,025,577 tons and products of agriculture increased 1.8 per cent to 4,712,300 tons. Decreases were reported for L.C.L. freight (less-than-carload) and animal products. L.C.L. declined 49.7 per cent to 37,329 tons and animal products fell 8.4 per cent to 188,603 tons.

On a geographic basis, Newfoundland loadings rose 15.9 per cent; Manitoba 15.4 per cent; Yukon and Northwest Territories 14.5 per cent; Nova Scotia 13.3 per cent; New Brunswick 11.6 per cent; British Columbia 8.9 per cent; Quebec 6.7 per cent and Ontario 6.0 per cent. Decreases occurred in Alberta 8.8 per cent; Saskatchewan 3.8 per cent and Prince Edward Island 0.4 per cent.

Revenue freight terminated on railway lines in Canada and delivered to U.S. rail connections increased 5.3 per cent to 49,597,271 tons. Of this total, 39,579,562 tons were unloaded in Canada (including deliveries to water lines) and 10,017,709 tons were delivered to U.S. rail connections. This compares with 37,351,926 tons terminated in Canada and 9,756,423 tons delivered to U.S. rail connections in the first quarter of 1968.
