## OPERATING REVENUSAS, EXPENSES \& STATTSNTTAS

## OF

RAILINAYS TITE AN ANVUAL OPERATING REVENUE CF $\$ 500,000$
For the Month of May 1921.

The railways as a whole continue to chow a slight improvement. The revenues have been falling oif since March, but the expenses have also been reduced so thai the net revenue has increased. The operatine ratio has slowly but steadily improved since the first of the year and it also has been lower each month than for the corresponding montio in lozj, The operating rafio for May wai 95.29 per cent afginst 95.55 per cent for Mey 1920, 96.17 per cent for April 1921, 95.64 per cent for March, 105 l per cent fois February and 108.0 per cent for January.

The Canadian Pacifjic Railway has been responsible to a larce extent for this lavourtile showing. The operating ratio of that road has steadily decreased since January wien it was 95.5 per cent For May it was 76.57 per cent. against 81. 55 per cont for May 1920. Of the 52 large smerican railruads reported by the Interstate Commerce Commission for May 1921 cnly 5 show a lower operating ratio than this.

The operating revenues show a decrease of $\$ 3,149,800$ from Nay 1920 and $\$ 734,2.17$ from Apxil 192il. This mas mainly in the freisht receipts which decreased \$2, 794, 790 from May 1920 and $\$ 1,379,261$ from April 19?3. The tons of frofght moved decrensed from $8,589,270$ tons in May 1920 to $5,855,595$ tons and the avarege haul also decreased from 2.6C.7 miles to 232.2 wiles so that the tons of revenue froieht moped one mile docreased $2 \delta_{0} 5$ per conto The average receipts per ton ner mile was 1.372 cents acainst 1.087 cents; in liay 1520 an increase of 26 per cent. The passengers carried decreared 444,430 or 11 per cent, aria the average passenger journey decreased ixom 68.4 miles to 64.0 mileis. Thess caused a decrease in the passengers carried one mile vi about $1 y$ per cent. The average passenger receipis increased from 2.814 conts to $Z_{3} 3.54$ cents or over i. per cent. Of tha 20 per cent increase in passenger fares granted last septomber, 10 per cent was reduced in January and 10 per cent remained till jume 30 th.

The operating expenses were reduced $\$ 3,092,468$ or 9 per cent from May 1920 and 93,026 or 3 per cent from April 1921. D'he pay roll was $\$ 15,75 \%, 2 \% 7$ ageinst $\$ 19,285,456$ for May 1920 and $\$ 18,999,980$ for April 1921. This was a decrease of 18 and 17 per cent respectiveiy..
