OPERATING LEVENUES, EXPENSES & STATISTICS

STEAM RAILWAYS OF CAMADA -

WITH ANNUAL OPERATING REVENUES OF \$500,000

For the Month of July 1922

The railways as a whole showed very little change in the operations from July 1921. Net operating revenues increased \$190,324 and the operating ratio was reduced from 93.88 per cent to 93.13 per cent. Freight traffic increased 5.1 per cent but freight revenues were only .53 per cent over last year's while both passenger traffic and passenger revenues declined. Total revenues showed a decrease of \$1,166,723 or 3.2 per cent while expenses were reduced \$1,357,048 or 4 per cent, transportation expenses being cut \$1,039,651 or 6.8 per cent with an increase of 2 per cent in freight train miles and .9 per cent in passenger train miles.

Average net load per train mile was 7 tons less while the average load per car was 1.3 tons lighter. Both average receipts per ton mile and per passenger mile show the effects in the cuts in rates.

CAMADIAN NATIONAL MAILWAYS. The operating deficit of the Canadian National Railways increased from \$1,334,568 to \$1,633,001 an increase of \$298,433. Freight traffic and freight revenues were practically on a parity with July 1921 but passenger earnings, due to lower rates, declined \$171,751 or 5.6 per cent with an increase in passenger miles of 2.9 per cent. Net loading of freight trains showed hardly any change but car loading declined 1.1 tens per car, thereby adding an additional loaded car to each train. Maintenance of way and structures decreased \$54,713 or 2.6 per cent but maintenance of equipment increased \$343,255 or 15.8 per cent while total expenses increased \$49,840 or .48 per cent.

The cut in wages last year became effective July 16 making the difference in the pay roll with an increase in the number of employees of 4.5 per cent, a decrease of \$112,706 or 1.6 per cent.

CAMADIAN PACIFIC PAILWAY. Freight traffic showed practically no change from July 1921 but freight revenues declined \$613,365 or 6.7 per cent. Passenger traffic, however, fell off 13,925,566 passenger miles of 9.2 per cent and with the lower rates produced revenues \$655,395 or 15.6 per cent less than in 1921. Total revenues showed a decline of \$1,453.507 or 9 per cent while expenses were reduced \$1,276,063 or 9.1 per cent, giving an operating ratio of 56.96 per cent as against 37.04 per cent for July:1921.

Maintenance of equipment expenses were heavier than in June but were \$236,907 or 24.9 per cent less than for July 1921. Last year, however, July maintenance of equipment expenses increased 50 per cent over June expenses.

Freight train miles increased 8.2 per cent with an increase in total traffic of 5.4 per cent, indicating lighter loading of trains by 74.2 net tons per train. This was due to lighter loading of cars as the average number of cars per train was practically the same as las year. Light movement of coal and grain this year, undoubtedly, helped to reduce the average load per car which decreased 2.9 tons.

GRAND TRUNK RAILWAY'S operating ratio of 79.7 per cent for July was the lowest on record. (The first month covered by these reports being January 1920). Net operating revenues amounted to \$1,454,933 an increase over July 1901 of \$538,208.

Freight traffic increased 31 per cent with freight revenues \$502,309 or 19 per cent over last year's. While passenger traffic increased 26 per cent over June it was slightly below July 1921 and with lower rates, revenues were \$205,677 or 11.7 per cent less than for last year. Total revenues increased \$575,025 or 6.7 per cent while operating expenses showed an increase of only .67 per cent.

The heavier traffic was handled at pragtically the same transportation cost as last year with an increase in freight train miles of only 1.4 per cent.

The average net load per freight train was 531.0 tons as against 418.2 tons in July 1921 and with heavier loading of cars the number of loaded cars per train was increased only 2.5 with a decrease of 2.1 in the number of empties. This improvement was effected despite a light movement of coal which would tend to decrease the average load per car.
