OPERATING REVENUES, EXPENSES & STATISTICS

STEAM RAILWAYS OF CANADA

WITH ANNUAL OPERATING REVENUES OF \$500,000.

For the Month of January, 1924

The railways as a whole showed practically no change in operating revenues from last year. A saving was effected however, in operating expenses of \$1,136,757 which increased the net operating revenue by \$1,076,030 and reduced the operating ratio from 97.92 per cent to 94.69 per cent. Freight traffic fell off 4.5 per cent which reduced freight revenues by \$494,728 or 2 per cent. Passenger traffic showed an increase of 4 per cent with an increase in passenger revenues of \$378,416, or 7 per cent. The total pay roll was cut by \$118,359, or .6 per cent for a reduction of 1,803 in the number of employees.

Average train loading declined from 542.4 net tons to 527.3 net tons and the average car load also was less by .7 ton. The average receipts per ton mile showed a slight increase from .941 cent to .967 cent.

CANADIAN NATIONAL RAILWAYS (Canadian Lines) turned an operating deficit of \$963,137 for January 1923 into a net operating revenue of \$16,989 which was a betterment of \$980,126.

Freight traffic fell off 12.1 per cent and freight revenue declined \$568,072 or 4.8 per cent. With increased passenger traffic of 3.7 per cent, passenger receipts were increased \$176,414, or 7.6 per cent and with the exception of mail revenues, all other revenues also showed increases. Cuts were effected in maintenance of way and structures expenses of \$467,003, or 17 per cent, in transportation expenses of \$947,163, or 10 per cent and in general expenses of \$40,856, or 7.5 per cent, reducing total operating expenses by \$1,269,809, or 7.6 per cent and reducing the operating ratio from 106.10 per cent for January 1923 to 99.89 per cent.

Average train loading showed a decrease of 13.1 net tons and the average load per car, a decrease of 1.3 tons of revenue freight.

Canadian National lines in Canada and the United States, (see page 6) showed an improvement in net operating revenues of \$1,029,542 with a decrease of \$294,413, or 1.5 per cent in gross operating revenues and a reduction of \$1,323,955, or 7 per cent in operating expenses.

CANADIAN PACIFIC RAILWAY - Commencing with this report, the data for the Canadian Pacific Railway will include revenues, expenses, etc. of the Canadian Pacific Railway only and not those of the Montreal and Atlantic and Esquimalt and Nanaimo railways as in previous reports. These railways, however, are included with "All Railways". The 1923 data of the Canadian Pacific Railway has been re-stated and is comparable with the 1924 data.

Preight revenues showed an increase of \$215,613, or 2.4 per cent for an increase of 4.6 per cent in revenue ton miles and with a decrease in transportation expenses of \$221,438, or 3.4 per cent. Passenger revenues also increased \$121,129, or 5.7 per cent for an increase of 3.8 per cent in passenger traffic.

Total revenues were increased by \$286,641, or 2.2 per cent and total operating expenses by \$80,445, or .6 per cent which increased the net operating revenues by \$206,195 and reduced the operating ratio from 96.08 per cent for January 1923 to 94.59 per cent. The pay roll was increased \$260,329, or 3.8 per cent for an increase of 2.6 per cent in the number of employees.
