OPERATING REVENUES, EXPENSES & STATISTICS
STEAM RAILWAYS OF CANADA

WITH AUGUAL OPERATING REVENUES OF \$500,000.

For the Month of November, 1924

Compared with November, 1923 which was the high record month in the history of Canadian railways, the freight traffic for November, 1924 showed a decrease of 21.8 per cent and freight revenues were less by \$5,332,232, or 14.6 per cent. The lighter grain movement was the main factor in this large decrease. The exports, while not an accurate measure of the movement, give a rough comparison: for November, wheat exports aggregated 27,000,000 bushels in 1924 and 64,000,000 in 1923; barley showed an increase of 5,000,000 bushels and oats, a decrease of 500,000 bushels. The average haul for grain (600 to 700 miles) is so much above the averages for other freight that on a ton mile basis, such differences in tonnage as these greatly affect the total ton miles.

Passenger traffic also showed a decrease of 14.8 per cent with a decline in passenger receipts of \$1,259,091,0\$ 18.1 per cent.

Total revenues were reduced by \$7,393,636, or 15.3 per cent, so that with a saving in operating expenses of \$5,470,555, net operating revenues were reduced by \$1,923,081. The pay roll showed a cut of \$2,494,231, or 12 per cent for a reduction of 9.4 per cent in the number of employees. Freight train revenues were increased 25 cents per train mile and the loading was only slightly below last year's.

For the eleven months, January-November, gross revenues showed a decrease of \$23,173,055, expenses, a decrease of \$21,927,997 and net operating revenues, a decrease of \$1,245,056.

CANADIAN NATIONAL RAILWAYS

With a reduction in freight traffic of 19 per cent and in passenger traffic of 16 per cent, revenues were less than in November, 1923 by \$2,707,598, or 12.9 per cent. Operating expenses were reduced by \$1,953,655, or 11.5 per cent by cutting maintenance of way and structures \$83,528, or 3.5 per cent, maintenance of equipment \$615,140, or 15.2 per cent and reducing transportation expenses by \$1,144,641, or 12.2 per cent. The operating ratio was raised from 80.49 per cent to 81.71 per cent and the net operating revenues were less by \$755,942. The reduction in the pay roll was \$1,010,492 or 9.1 per cent for a reduction of 6.7 per cent in the number of employees. Despite the lighter traffic, train loading was only 5 per cent lighter, the average expenses per train mile was greater by 55 cents and the average expenses per train mile were practically unchanged.

For the period January-November, the Canadian lines show an increase in net operating revenues of \$593,701 but the United States lines show a decrease of \$2,832,822, reducing the net operating revenues for the entire system by \$2,239,121.

CANADIAN PACIFIC RAILIAY

Preight traffic showed a decrease from November, 1923 of 26.2 per cent although it was 3 per cent heavier than October, 1924. Freight revenues were consequently reduced to the extent of \$3,283,338, or 19.4 per cent and passenger revenues were also down \$475,763, or 16 per cent. Total revenues showed a decline of \$4,123,678, or 18.7 per cent and net operating revenues were less by \$1,086,889. The operating ratio, however, was also reduced from 67.33 per cent to \$5.88 per cent. The reduction in operating expenses amounted to \$3,036,789, or 20.4 per cent, the largest cuts being \$1,242,613 in maintenance of way and structures and \$1,195,676 in transportation expenses.

Although for the eleven months the gross revenues were reduced by \$8,669,260, expenses were cut by \$8,859,867 increasing net operating revenues by \$190,607.


