



OPERATING REVENUES, EXPENSES & STATISTICS

STEAM RAILWAYS OF CANADA

WITH ANNUAL OPERATING REVENUES OF \$500,000.

FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER, 1925.

The freight traffic of the railways as a whole for October was heavier than in 1924 by 10.8 per cent and although it was below that of October, 1923 and 1923, the revenue ton miles for the two months, September and October, were the greatest this year ever made by Canadian railways. The earlier harvest this year advanced the movement of grain considerably. Car loadings passed the 70,000 cars mark the week ended September 19 remaining above that point for 12 consecutive weeks, whereas in 1924 they were over 70,000 cars for only 3 weeks and in 1923 for only 7 weeks.

Revenues aggregated \$48,722,639, an increase over 1924 of \$4,369,078 or 9.9 per cent. Operating expenses showed very little change; maintenance of way and structures expenses were reduced \$367,564, or 6 per cent, maintenance of equipment expenses were increased \$633,819, or 9.8 per cent and the total expenses were greater by \$407,221, or 1.3 per cent. The net operating revenue was increased \$3,961,856 and the operating ratio was reduced to 65.71 per cent which is the lowest since these monthly reports were inaugurated, (January, 1920). The average freight receipts per ton mile were increased from .920 cents in 1924 to .934 cents which, with no increases in grain rates, would indicate an increase in volume of higher class freight.

Freight traith loading was heavier than in 1924 and approximately the same as in 1923. Passenger traffic was heavier than last year by 11 per cent and with a decrease in passenger train miles, train loading showed an increase of 6.2 passengers and revenues per passenger train mile, an increase of 8 cents.

For the ten months, January - October, net revenues were greater by \$12,835,154

CANADIAN NATIONAL RAILWAYS: The operating ratio for October, 69.25 per cent, was the lowest since the amalgamation of the system. Gross revenues aggregated \$25,761,136, being \$610,465 greater than in October, 1923, the previous high month and with operating expenses at \$16,455,300, the net operating revenues amounted to \$7,305,836. This was an increase of \$3,144,686 over October, 1924 and of \$2,577,828 over October, 1923.

Maintenance of May and structures was reduced \$63,940, or 2 per cent from last year's expenses and maintenance of equipment expenses were increased by \$737,043, or 25 per cent. This large increase was more from a cut in 1924 than heavy expenditures in 1925; the cumulative totals to the end of October were 2 per cent less than in 1924 and less by 5 per cent than 1925 and 1922.

Freight traffic showed an incr ease over last year's of 26.6 per cent and passenger traffic also was heavier by 14.8 per cent. Freight train loading increased from 648.3 net tons to 697.3 net tons with the average car load one ton heavier.

The lines in the United States also made a better showing in both gross and net operating revenues, the latter for the entire system being larger than in 1924 by \$3,466,115.

For January - October, the net operating revenues for the Canadian lines were increased by \$7,840,730, for the United States lines by \$1,875,326 and for the entire system by \$9,716,056.

CANADIAN PACIFIC RAILWAY: The gross revenues for October, (\$19,527,588) were \$253,376, or 1.3 per cent larger than in 1924 and have been exceeded only by the revenues earned in October and November, 1923. Net operating revenues have been exceeded by only those of October, 1923.

Freight traffic showed an increase over last year's of only 3 per cent; the heavy movement starting so much earlier this year made the big increase in September and although passenger traffic showed an increase of 6.1 per cent, passenger receipts were less by \$34,907. Mail and express revenues also showed slight declines. Maintenance expenses were reduced for both way and structures and equipment, total operating expenses being less by \$224,774, or 1.8 per cent.

For the ten months, January - October, gross revenues and operating expenses were less than in 1924 but net operating revenues were increased by \$2,525,488.


