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OPERATING REVENUES, EXPENSES & STATISTICS STEAM RAILWAYS OF CANADA WITH ANNUAL OPERATING REVENUES OF \$500,000 FOR THE MONTH OF MAY, 1986

The large increases in revenues and freight traffic for May as compared with those of May, 1925, were the result of a very heavy grain movement to the head of the lakes in 1936. Navigation was late, not opening until May 3rd, elevators had been congested and receipts were light during March and April, being only 6,700,000 bushels as against 27,000,000 in 1925 despite the larger crop, and when the embargoes were lifted and navigation opened, the grain came forward in large quantities, total receipts for May amounting to 27,000,000 bushels as against 10,800,000 for May, 1925. Goal traffic was light in 1925 and substantial increases were recorded in merchandise and miscellaneous freight in 1926.

Gross revenues were heavier by \$7,114,311, or 22 per cent for an increase of 41.1 per cent in freight traffic and 10 per cent in passenger traffic. Operating expenses were increased by \$2,690,361 and net operating revenues were larger by \$4,423,950, the operating ratio being reduced from 94.42 per cent to 84.23 per cent.

CANADIAN NATIONAL RAILWAYS earned a net revenue of \$2,241,981 as against a deficit in 1925 of \$191,731. Freight traffic showed an increase of 43.5 per cent and passenger traffic an increase of 17.4 per cent. Although the traffic was so much heavier and train loading was increased 53.1 revenue tons or 11 per cent, the earnings per freight train mile were less than last year by 11 cents on account of a greater proportion of the freight being low class, the earnings per ton mile dropping from 1.180 cents to 1.037 cents or 14 per cent.

The lines in the United States showed an improvement but not to the same extent as the Canadian lines, the net revenues for the entire system showing a gain of \$2,826,426. For the five months, January - May, net revenues for the system were \$12,915,582 as against \$4,174,721 in 1925 the Canadian lines earning 68 per cent of it in 1926 and only 32 per cent in 1925.

CANADIAN PACIFIC RAILWAY— Freight traffic for May was 48 per cent heavier than in 1925 but the average earnings per ton mile were 8 per cent less so that freight revenues increased only \$2,891,258 or 36 per cent; the heavy movement of grain was chiefly responsible for this. The heavier loading of trains increased the earnings per freight train mile by 51 cents, or 10 per cent. Operating expenses were heavier by \$1,467,862, or 12.8 per cent and the operating ratio was reduced from 92.75 per cent to 84.01 per cent.

For the first five months gross revenues were heavier in 1926 by \$8,272,149 and net revenues by \$5,244,559.

The two charts on pages 7 and 8 were designed to give some indication of what might be expected during the last six months of this year and to show that in the very favourable comparisons of 1926 gross revenues with those of 1925, the relatively light revenue of the first six months of 1925 was an exceedingly important factor.

The large harvest of 1933 provided a heavy movement of agricultural products for the first seven months of 1924, the increase over 1923 being more than 24 million tens. The smaller harvest of 1924 materially reduced this tonnage for the second half of 1924 and for the first half of 1925, and the 1925 crop produced a good movement for September 1925 to June 1926. To retain the gain over 1925 so far made by the railways, the traffic conditions must at least



equal those of the autumn of last year which were much better than those of 1924.

The tables below give comparisons of the gross revenues for the first six menths of 1926 with those of 1923, 1924 and 1925 and also show what was earned during the second half of 1923, 1924 and 1925. The June, 1926, data were compiled from the weekly estimated revenues for the Canadian National and Canadian Pacific railways. Net operating revenues which are available for only the first five menths show a much greater rate of increase than gross revenues on account of operating expenses having been increased only slightly over those of 1935 and reduced to below those of 1924 and 1923.
