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# OPFRAMING REVINUES, EXPENSES \& STATISTICS 

SIEAM: RAIITNAYS OF CAVADA
WITH ANIUAL OPERATING RIVENUES OF $\$ 500,000$

The increase of 13.8 per cent in revenue ton miles of all railways was all in the western provinces and was mainly from the large carry-over of grain and the increased movement of coal, lumber, pulpwood and other forest products. The heavy crop in Alberta and Saskatchewan increased the average haul on grain moving to the head of the lakes. Also, the heavier movement to the Pacific ports increased the avcrage haul, whic for all freight was 328.5 miles, as against 295 miles in Jamary 1927.

The average revenue per ton mile was reduced from .919 cent in 1927 to .855 cent and freight revenues increased by 5.8 per cent, or by $\$ 1,517,372$. Passenger revenues were heavier by $\$ 201,240$, or 3.6 per cent and total gross revenues were heavier by $\$ 1,795,776$, or 5 per cent. All general accounts of operating expenses registered increases and the total was larger by $\$ 1,766,22 \%$, or 5.6 per cent. Net onerating revenues increased by $\$ 29,550$, but the operating income declined by $\$ 189,953$. The total pay roll was heavier by $\$ 1,376,140$, or 7 per cent for an increase of 5,852 employees. Although the train loading was heavier by 18.9 revenue tons, the earnings per train mile were lighter by 16 cents, due to a larger percentage of the freight being grain and other low class freight.

CANADIAN NATIONAL RAILTAYS.- The data for January 1927 have been restated to be directly comparable with 192 data with the Eastern Lines eliminated, except for the pay roll and omployees, the total for all Canadian lines being shown in the Canadian National table.

Grcss revenues were heavier by $\$ 1,130,023$ and were greater than for any previous january. Operating expenses also increased by $\$ 877,173$, or 6.6 per cent and the net operating revenues were larger by $\$ 252,849$. Revenue tons carried increased by 5.1 per cent, but the revenue ton miles increased by 22.8 per cent through the average haul increasing from 336.5 miles to 393.1 miles. Passenger traffic showed a slight decline, but the revenues increased through a higher average receipt per passenger mile. Freight train loading was heavier by 28.1 gross tons and by 38 revenue tons, but the revenue per train mile was less by $2^{\prime}+$ cents.

The lines in the United States showed a decrease in operating revenues and an increase in operating expenses, so that the system net cperating revenues were larger by only $\$ 88$,, 10 and the operating income by $\$ 70,905$.

EASTERN IINES OF CANADIAN NATIONAL RAILTAYS.- Freight traffic was lighter than in 2927 by 8.8 per cent, freight revemues were reduced by $\$ 228,461$, or 16.9 per cent and total cperating revenues were iighter by $\$ 222,900$, or 10.9 per cent. Operating expenses showed increases in all general accounts except maintenance of equipment, the total being heavier by $\$ 98,172$, or 4.3 per cent, increasirg the operating deficit by $\$ 321,072$. The average revenue per ton mile was .763 cent as against .837 cent, a reducticn of 9 per cent. Train lcading was heavier by 14.1 revenue tons, but lighter by 47 grass tons and the average revenue pertrainmile was reduced by 19 cents.

CANADIAN PACIFIC RAIITAY.- GOerating revenues were the largest earned in any January and exceeded those of January, 1927, by $\$ 967,660$, or 6.7 per cent. Operating expenses were heavier by $\$ 525,735$, or 4.1 per cent, net operating revenues were increased by $\$ 441,925$ and the cperating income by $\$ 367,801$.

The increase in the total pay roll was $\$ 564,892$, or 7.9 per cent for an increase of 3,895 , or 7.2 per cent in the number of employees.

Expenditures on maintenance of equipment were the heaviest of any month during the past five years, but maintenance of way and structures, while heavior than for January, 2927, by 8.6 per cent, was not high compared with cther menths.
