#### OPERATING REVENUES, EXPENSES & STATISTICS

#### STEAM RAILWAYS OF CANADA

#### WITH ANNUAL OPERATING REVENUES OF \$500,000

#### FOR THE MONTH OF DECEMBER, 1930

Gross revenues of Canadian railways for December amounted to \$33,449,501 which was less than for December, 1929, by \$6,541,144 and was the smallest earned in December during the past decade. Passenger revenues were particularly light, being 29.9 per cent under those of December, 1929. Operating expenses were reduced by \$5,483,116 and the net revenues amounted to \$5,910,385, or \$1,058,027 less than in 1929.

EASTERN LINES - CANADIAN NATIONAL RAILWAYS: With a decrease in freight traffic of 13.4 per cent and in passenger traffic of 29.8 per cent, gross revenues declined by \$371,999, or 13.7 per cent, and operating expenses were reduced by \$407,283, or 14.1 per cent. Despite the heavy reduction in operating expenses the operating income showed a debit of \$492,247, as against a debit of \$515,407 in 1929.


CANADIAN NATIONAL RAILWAYS: Gross revenues amounted to \$12,854,099, or \$3,816,098 less than in 1929, and operating expenses were reduced by \$2,498,166, or 17.0 per cent, making the net revenues \$672,593 as against \$1,990,524 in 1929. The pay roll amounted to \$10,799,409, or a reduction of \$1,230,414, for a decrease of 5,781 in the number of employees. The average passenger train revenues per train mile amounted to \$1.99, which was 60 cents, or 23 per cent, less than the average for December, 1929.

The lines in the United States all showed smaller gross revenues, but reductions in operating expenses on the Grand Trunk Western lines produced an increase in the net revenues of all United States lines of \$95,796. The net revenues for the system (exclusive of Eastern Lines) amounted to \$817,572, which was a reduction from 1929 of \$1,222,135.

CANADIAN PACIFIC RAILWAY: Gross revenues amounted to \$14,185,394, or \$1,266,767 below revenues of December, 1929, and, with a reduction in operating expenses of \$1,581,124, net revenues were increased by \$314,356. The reduction in the total pay roll was only \$236,602, or 7.3 per cent, and in the number of employees, only 1,129, or 2.1 per cent. The average number of passengers per train decreased from 58.4 in 1929 to 42.2 and average revenues per train mile were reduced by 72 cents, or 26.4 per cent.
