OPERATING REVENUES, EXPENSES & STATISTICS

STEAM RAILWAYS OF CANADA

WITH ANNUAL OPERATING REVENUES OF \$500,000

FOR THE MONTH OF MAY, 1930

Gross operating revenues for Canadian railways for May amounted to \$37,844,720, as against \$45,347,371 in 1929 and \$43,654,787 in 1928. Operating expenses amounted to \$33,737,926, or \$5,349,748 less than in 1929, maintenance of way and structures decreasing by \$2,550,541, or 24.3 per cent, and maintenance of equipment by \$1,146,884, or 13.0 per cent. Net operating revenues were reduced by \$2,152,902 and the pay roll was less than in May, last year, by \$3,115,243, or 12.2 per cent, for a reduction of 27,218 in the number of employees. Freight traffic continued light, being 23 per cent less than in 1929 and passenger traffic also decreased by 12 per cent.

For January - May, gross revenues amounted to \$179,172,253 and net operating revenues to \$19,729,911, as against \$212,072,799 and \$36,045,639, respectively, in 1929.

EASTERN LINES - CANADIAN NATIONAL RAILWAYS: Operating revenues were lighter than for May, 1929, by \$25,785 and operating expenses were reduced by \$188,387, thus reducing the net operating revenue debit by \$162,602. Freight traffic amounted to 132,257,492 revenue ton miles, as against 171,591,571 ton miles in April and 155,367,743 ton miles in May, 1929.

For January - May, gross revenues amounted to \$12,801,035 and the operating income deficit to \$1,389,043, as against \$12,332,440 and a deficit of \$1,453,682 in 1929.

CANADIAN NATIONAL RAILWAYS: Gross revenues for May, amounting to \$15,354,895, were less than in 1929 by \$3,237,500, or 17.4 per cent. Operating expenses were reduced by \$2,811,037, or 17.1 per cent, and the net operating revenue, amounting to \$1,726,741, was less by \$426,462. Freight traffic decreased by 20 per cent and passenger traffic by 8.2 per cent. The decrease in the total pay roll amounted to \$1,852,044, or 13.7 per cent, for a decrease in employees of 17,154, or 16.5 per cent.

The lines in the United States all showed smaller gross revenues than in 1929 and, with the exception of the New England Lines, also showed decreases in net operating revenues, the system (exclusive of Eastern Lines) showing a decrease in gross revenues of \$4,298,256 and in net operating revenues of \$956,803.

For January - May, Canadian lines showed a decrease in net operating revenues of \$7,082,579 and United States lines a decrease of \$2,952,216, making a decrease for the system of \$10,034,795.

CANADIAN PACIFIC RAILWAY: With a decrease in freight traffic of 29.1 per cent and in passenger traffic of 18.5 per cent, gross revenues were less than for May, 1929, by \$3,285,569, or 18.1 per cent. The reduction in operating expenses was \$1,965,545, or 12.8 per cent, which reduced the net operating revenues by \$1,320,024. The total pay roll was reduced by \$1,107,909, or 11.1 per cent, and the number of employees was reduced by 8,962, or 11.3 per cent.

For January - May, gross revenues amounted to \$68,160,313 and the operating income to \$6,585,971, as against \$84,100,285 and \$13,363,905, respectively, in 1929.
