### OPERATING RETENUES, EXPENSES & STATISTICS

STEAM RAILWAYS OF CAHADA

WITH ANNUAL CPARATING REVENUES OF \$500,000

FOR THE MONTH OF INCOMBEP, 1931


Gross revenues of Canadian railways for December amounted to \$27,731,543, which was \$5,545,746, or 16.7 per cent, less than for December 1930. Operating expenses were reduced from \$27,387,969 in 1930 to \$23,769,376 and the operating income was reduced from \$4,780,867 to \$3,380,153. Freight traffic was lighter than in 1930 by 16.1 per cent and passenger traffic declined by 19.0 per cent. The total pay roll amounted to \$16,143 516 as against \$19,462,692 for December 1930 and the average number of employees was reduced by 17,284.

EASTERN LINES - CANADIAN NATIONAL RAILWAYS: With a reduction in freight traffic of 14.7 per cent and in passenger traffic of 28.5 per cent, gross revenues decreased from \$2,341,468 in 1930 to \$1,859,758 and operating expenses decreased from \$2,475,420 to \$2,127,237. The operating income loss increased from \$492,247 to \$536,130.

CANADIAN NATICIAL RATIWAYS: (Canadian Lines exclusive of Eastern Lines) - Net operating revenues for December were less than a third of the December 1930 net revenues, amounting to only \$199,913. Gross revenues decreased from \$12,854.099 to \$11,541,773 and operating expenses from \$12,131,506 to \$11,341,859. The total pay roll, including the Eastern Lines', amounted to \$3,979,795 which was \$1,819,611, or 16.8 per cent, less than in 1930 and the number of employees was less by 7,986, or 9.7 per cent. Both freight and passenger trains showed higher average earnings per train mile than in 1930, freight trains increasing from \$5,12 to \$5.33 and passenger trains from \$1.99 to \$2.14, due to slightly heavier loading but more to higher average receipts per ton mile and per passenger mile.


The United States Lines all showed reduced gross revenues, but, by a cut in operating expenses by the Daluth, Winnipeg and Pacific of 46 per cent, that line increased its net revenue, but the other lines had such heavy losses that for the system (exclusive of Eastern Lines) the operating income of \$446,133 in December 1930 was reduced to a loss of \$56,379.

CANADIAN PACIFIC RATLWAY: Gross revenues declined from \$14,222,691 in 1930 to \$11,274,769, or by 20.7 per cent, and operating expenses were reduced from \$9,711,093 to \$7,511,967, or by 22.6 per cent. The net operating revenue was reduced from \$4,511,597 to \$3,762,802 and the operating income from \$4,203,713 to \$3,676,607. Freight traffic declined by 22.9 per cent and passenger traffic by 10.5 per cent. The average passenger journey increased from \$1.1 to 87.4 miles, but the average freight haul decreased from 454.7 to 419.4 miles. The total pay roll amounted to \$5,952,544 as against \$7,069,554 in 1930.
