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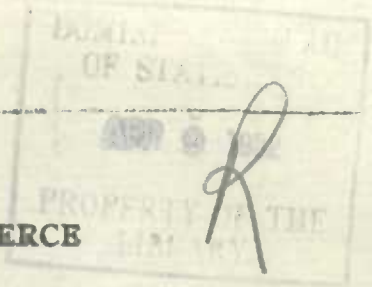

OPERATING REVENUES, EXPENSES & STATISTICS

STEAM RAILWAYS OF CANADA

WITH ANNUAL OPERATING REVENUES OF \$500,000

FOR THE MONTH OF JANUARY, 1932

Gross revenues of Canadian railways for January amounted to \$22,120,450 which was a decrease of \$5,954,526, or 21.2 per cent, from the earnings of January 1931. Operating expenses were reduced by \$5,944,416, or 21.4 per cent, or to \$21,780,907, and net operating revenues were reduced from \$349,653 in 1931 to \$339,543. Freight traffic showed a decrease of 20.5 per cent and passenger traffic a decrease of 25.6 per cent. The total pay roll amounted to \$14,979,524 as against \$19,239,845 last year and the number of employees was reduced from 148,149 to 124,010.

The average earnings per freight train mile were reduced from \$4.77 to \$4.41 and passenger train earnings per train mile were reduced from \$1.65 to \$1.50, due to a reduction of passengers per train from 38.3 to 34.4 and also to a reduction in the average receipt per passenger mile from 2.918 cents to 2.765 cents.

EASTERN LINES - CANADIAN NATIONAL RAILWAYS: Gross revenues amounting to \$1,608,456 were less than in 1931 by \$287,619, but operating expenses were reduced by \$612,170, or to \$1,991,996, and the operating deficit was reduced from \$708,092 to \$383,540. Passenger traffic declined only 18.2 per cent as against 35.3 per cent on the remainder of the system in Canada. The average revenues per train mile, however, were low, being only \$1.51.

CANADIAN NATIONAL RAILWAYS-(Canadian Lines exclusive of Eastern Lines): With a reduction in gross revenues of \$2,179,113 and in operating expenses of \$2,344,585, the operating loss was reduced by \$165,472, or from \$725,516 in January 1931 to \$560,044. The operating income showed a smaller improvement, the debit being \$746,650 as against \$834,790 in 1931. Freight traffic was lighter by 14.4 per cent and passenger traffic by 35.3 per cent, the passengers per train decreasing from 39.3 to 33.9. The total pay roll amounted to \$8,271,724 which was a reduction from 1931 of \$2,336,111, or 22.0 per cent, for a reduction in the number of employees of 11,092, or 13.5 per cent.

The lines in the United States all showed reduced gross and net revenues, the net operating revenues for the system (exclusive of Eastern Lines) being a debit of \$588,122 as against a debit of \$511,928 in 1931.

CANADIAN PACIFIC RAILWAY: The reports of the Canadian Pacific Railway, starting with January 1932, will include data for the Dominion Atlantic; New Brunswick Coal and Railway Company; Fredericton and Grand Lake Coal and Railway Company; Montreal and Atlantic; Quebec Central; Algoma Eastern and Esquimalt and Nanaimo railways and the 1931 data are restated to be comparable. The Kettle Valley Railway was taken over as a part of the system on January 1, 1931.

Gross revenues amounted to \$9,115,962 which was less than for January 1931 by \$2,745,641, or 23.1 per cent. Operating expenses were reduced by \$2,453,568 and the operating income, amounting to \$617,478, was reduced by \$244,769. The reduction in the pay roll amounted to \$1,678,211, or 22.5 per cent, for a reduction in the number of employees of 11,902, or 20.5 per cent.
