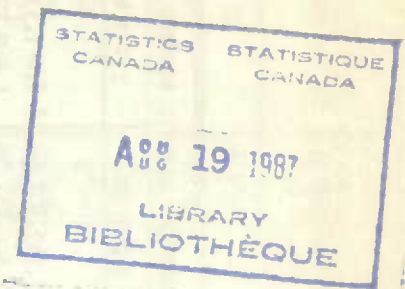

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**OPERATING REVENUES, EXPENSES & STATISTICS  
RAILWAYS IN CANADA  
WITH ANNUAL OPERATING REVENUES OF  
\$500,000 OR OVER**



DECEMBER, 1935

Gross revenues of Canadian railways for December amounted to \$26,656,309 in 1935 and \$24,777,608 in 1934. Operating expenses increased from \$19,902,194 in 1934 to \$21,332,386, net operating revenues increased from \$4,875,414 to \$5,323,423, and operating income increased from \$3,623,775 to \$4,238,621. Freight traffic was heavier than in 1934 by 11.3 per cent and passenger traffic was heavier by 3.2 per cent. The total pay roll increased from \$12,135,376 to \$13,261,571, or by 8.8 per cent, for an increase of 3,049 employees, or 2.8 per cent.

CANADIAN NATIONAL RAILWAYS: Canadian lines earned \$12,305,237 in December, as against \$11,490,416 in 1934, operating expenses increased by \$468,433, and the operating income was greater by \$307,151. All four lines in the United States also showed increased gross revenues and, although the Duluth, Winnipeg and Pacific and the New England Lines showed debits for operating income, the improvements on the Grand Trunk Western and the Central Vermont more than offset the losses and the system operating income increased from \$993,746 in 1934 to \$1,639,917.

CANADIAN PACIFIC RAILWAY: Gross revenues were greater than in December, 1934, by \$722,138, or 6.8 per cent, increasing from \$10,653,454 to \$11,375,592, operating expenses increased from \$7,230,695 to \$7,947,653 and the operating income from \$3,171,408 to \$3,306,013. The number of employees increased only 123, or from 43,203 to 43,326, but the pay roll increased by \$314,831, or from \$4,723,811 to \$5,038,643.
