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

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OPERATING REVENUES, EXPENSES & STATISTICS RAILWAYS IN CANADA WITH ANNUAL OPERATING REVENUES OF \$500,000 OR OVER

DECEMBER, 1936



Gross revenues of Canadian railways for December increased from \$26,618,916 in 1935 to \$30,108,406 in 1936, or by 13.1 per cent. Operating expenses increased from \$21,355,934 to \$22,578,903 and the operating income increased from \$4,209,751 to \$6,385,042, or by \$2,175,291. Freight traffic was heavier by 11.7 per cent and passenger traffic increased by 20.5 per cent. The average number of employees increased 3,764, or 3.3 per cent, and the total pay roll increased from \$13,281,321 to \$14,042,763, or by 5.7 per cent.

CANADIAN NATIONAL RAILWAYS: Gross revenues of Canadian lines increased from \$12,259,368 in December, 1935, to \$14,066,022, or by \$1,806,634. Operating expenses increased by \$1,035,106 and the operating income increased from \$1,158,074 to \$1,879,936. All four of the railways in the United States showed increased revenues, raising the system gross revenues from \$14,919,844 to \$17,224,225. System operating expenses were increased from \$12,847,408 to \$14,318,676 and the operating income from \$1,639,917 to \$2,237,583.

CANADIAN PACIFIC RAILTAY COMPANY: With gross revenues increased by \$767.875, or from \$11.375.592 in December, 1935, to \$12,143,468 and operating expenses heavier by only \$443,059, net operating revenues were increased by \$324,815 and operating income by \$235,793, or from \$3,306,013 to \$3,541,807.
