RAILWAYS IN CANADA WITH ANNUAL OPERATING REVENUES OF \$500,000 OR OVER

MAY, 1936

Gross revenues of Canadian railways for May increased from \$24,537,334 in 1935 to \$27,022,242 and, with operating expenses increasing by only \$1,917,603, net operating revenues were increased by \$567,305, or from \$2,666,119 to \$3,233,424. Freight traffic, measured in ton miles, increased by 15.7 per cent and passenger traffic was heavier by 2.8 per cent.

For Jamary to May gross revenues increased from \$115,465,754 in 1935 to \$123,438,045, but the operating income declined from \$7,079,349 to \$6,586,871.

CANADIAN NATIONAL RAILWAYS: Gross revenues of the Canadian lines for May amounted to \$12,395,219, as against \$11,694,957 in 1935, and operating expenses increased from \$11,433,412 to \$12,153,729, reducing the net operating revenue by \$20,055 and increasing the operating income debit from \$51,128 in May 1935 to \$136,240. The lines in the United States all showed larger gross revenues but only the Grand Trunk Western earned larger net operating revenues and operating income, but this was sufficient to offset the decreases on the other United States lines and also on the Canadian lines and the system operating income was increased from \$93,819 to \$290,047.

For January - May the Canadian lines showed an operating income debit of \$2,200,450 as against a debit last year of \$764,779 and the United States lines increased their operating income by \$824,165, making the system operating income a debit of \$769,345 in 1936 and a debit of \$157,839 in 1935, an increase in the debit of \$611,506.

CANADIAN PACIFIC RAILWAY: Gross revenues for May increased to \$11,345,830 from \$9,885,776 last year, or by \$1,460,053, and, with an increase in operating expenses of \$988,197, net operating revenues increased by \$471,856 and the operating income by \$306,375, or from \$1,143,913 to \$1,450,289. Freight traffic was heavier by 20.2 per cent and passenger traffic by 8.0 per cent.

For January - May gross revenues were \$51,068,449 in 1936 and \$46,188,848 in 1935 and, with an increase in operating expenses of \$3,770,108, the net operating revenue was increased from \$6,286,379 to \$7,395,871 and the operating income from \$4,658,206 to \$5,615,450.

Joint facilities rents will not include miscellaneous credits and debits hereafter and an adjustment has been made in this report for these items included in January, February and March, 1936, accounts.
