OPERATING REVENUES, EXPENSES & STATISTICS RAILWAYS IN CANADA WITH ANNUAL OPERATING REVENUES OF \$500,000 OR OVER

FOR TWELVE MONTHS ENDED DECEMBER 31, 1938

Gross revenues of Canadian railways for 1938 amounted to \$333,094,287 as compared with \$351,342,880 in 1937. This was a decrease of \$18,248,592, or 5.2 per cent. Only in September and October were increases recorded. Operating expenses were reduced by \$4,822,619, or 1.6 per cent, and the operating income dropped from \$39,000,536 to \$25,012,390, or by \$13,988,146. Freight traffic was only slightly below the 1937 volume, but freight revenues declined by \$14,622,059, or 5.5 per cent. Passenger traffic was lighter by 7.6 per cent and passenger revenues declined by \$1,875,081, or 4.9 per cent. The monthly average number of employees decreased from 125,302 in 1937 to 119,228, or by 4.8 per cent, and the pay roll was increased from \$184,553,535 to \$185,969,336, or by 0.77 per cent. Reductions in basic rates of pay were partially restored in 1937, and the last 5 per cent was restored in 1938: 3 per cent on February 1st and 2 per cent on April 1st.

CANADIAN NATIONAL RAILWAYS: Canadian lines showed a drop in gross revenues of \$5,497,233 or from \$165,082,488 in 1937 to \$156,585,254 in 1938. Operating expenses were reduced by \$1,624,482 or from \$153,711,912 to \$152,087,430, and the operating income was reduced from \$7,571,404 to \$154,580. Total pay roll for the year was increased from \$99,964,873 in 1937 to \$100,690,521, and the average number of employees decreased from 69,291 to 66,175. All four lines in the United States showed reduced gross revenues and they all showed debits in operating incomes, whereas, all but the New England lines showed credits in 1937. The system gross revenues declined from \$198,396,608 in 1937 to \$132,241,722. Operating expenses were reduced from \$180,788,853 to \$176,175,311, and the operating income was reduced from \$9,509,401 to a debit of \$2,133,039, or by \$11,642,440.

CANADIAN PACIFIC RAILWAY COMPANY: Gross revenues for 1938 amounted to \$143,198,531 compared with \$145,201,160 in 1937. This was a decrease of \$2,002,629, or 1.4 per cent. Operating expenses were reduced by only \$3,595, or from \$117,069,540 to \$117,065,945, and the operating income was reduced by \$2,989,781, or from \$23,742,247 to \$20,752,465. Freight traffic increased by 3.4 per cent (this was largely due to the larger western grain crop.) and freight revenues showed a decrease of \$882,489 instead of an increase. Passenger traffic was lighter by 7.9 per cent and passenger revenues declined by \$501,587, or 3.0 per cent. The pay roll increased from \$71,944,021 to \$73,092,452 and the average number of employees was reduced from 48,177 to 46,101, or by 4.3 per cent.
