# OPERATING REVENUES, EXPENSES \& STATISTICS RAILWAYS IN CANADA WITH ANNUAL OPERATING REVENUES OF \$500,000 OR OVER 

FOR THE KONTH OF OCTOBER, 1939.

Canadian railways earned $\$ 39,6 B 1,437$ in October compared with $\$ 37,608,717$ in October, 1938. Operuting expenses were increesed from \$25,681,782 to $\$ 26,985,426$ and the operating income from $010,684,376$ to $\$ 11,221,517$. Tons of revenue freight carried increased by 11. 6 per cent but ton miles decreased by 4.4 per cent, the average haul declining from 408.0 miles to 349.8 miles. The average passenger journey also decreased from 98.8 miles fn 1938 to 93.5 miles . The totrl pay-roll increased from $\$ 15,587,923$ to \$16,903,466. For the ten months, gross revenues increased from ${ }^{*} 275,142,076$ in 1938 to $3293,390,866 ;$ operating expenses increased from $\$ 248,149,341$ to $\$ 252,286,980$; and the operating income from $\$ 14,913,522$ to $\$ 28,367,664$.

CANADIAN NATIONAL FAILFAYS - Gross revenues of Canadian lines for October amounted to \$18,996, 250 compared with $\$ 17,430,628$ in October 1938. Operuting expenses increased from $\$ 13,114,618$ to $\$ 14,194,078$ and the operating income was increased from $\$ 3,947,424$ to $\$ 4,381,193$. The New England lines showed a reduction in revenues, an increase in expenses and an increase in the operating income debit, but the other three IInes in the Unitad Stetes showed improvements in revenues and operating incomes, and the system gross revenues were increased from $\$ 19,935,153$ to $\$ 21,943,255$ and the operating income from $\$ 3,970,599$ to $\$ 4,665,470$. For January - october, aystam revenues increased from $\$ 150,272,587$ in 1938 to $\$ 164,189,092$ and the operating income from a debit of $\$ 4,437,299$ to e credit of $\$ 5,215,058$, an increase of $\$ 9,652,857$.

CANADIAN PACIFIC RAILWAY COMPANY - With a reduction in both freight and passenger traffic, gross revenues declined from $\$ 17,004,495$ in October 1938 to $\$ 16,781,250$. Operating expenses were reduced by $\$ 45,168$ and the operating income from $\$ 6,046,431$ to $\$ 5,844,166$. For Jenuary - October, gross revenues were incressed from $\$ 118,176,207$ in 1938 to $\$ 123,020,864$ and the operating income from $\$ 13,377,224$ to $\$ 18,549,577$.
