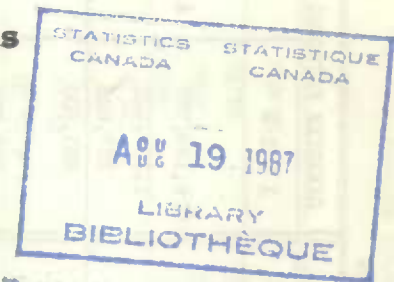

**OPERATING REVENUES, EXPENSES & STATISTICS
RAILWAYS IN CANADA
WITH ANNUAL OPERATING REVENUES OF
\$500,000 OR OVER**

FOR THE MONTH OF APRIL, 1939.



Gross earnings of Canadian railways for April amounted to \$25,191,096 or only \$451 less than the April 1938 earnings. Operating expenses were reduced by \$1,205,691 or from \$24,111,737 to \$22,906,046, increasing the net operating revenue from a debit of \$136,144 to a credit of \$1,029,044. Freight traffic increased by 6.3 per cent but passenger traffic decreased by 6.8 per cent. The number of employees was reduced by 4,497 or 3.8 per cent and the pay roll was reduced by \$871,304 or 5.7 per cent. The last of the reductions in basic rates of pay were restored April 1, 1938, consequently this is the first month for which expenses and pay roll are on the same footing in the last two years. For January - April, gross revenues were \$97,340,456 in 1939 and \$96,795,562 in 1938 and the operating income debit was reduced from \$2,854,267 in 1938 to \$650,461.

CANADIAN NATIONAL RAILWAYS: Canadian lines earned \$12,100,426 compared with \$11,985,659 in April last year. Operating expenses were reduced by \$558,472 and the operating income debit was reduced from \$991,952 to \$296,376. Each of the United States lines also showed increased gross revenues and operating incomes raising the system gross revenues from \$13,924,655 in 1938 to \$14,452,302 and reducing the operating income debit from \$1,577,670 to \$540,842. For January - April, gross revenues of the Canadian lines declined by \$1,438,124 but this was more than offset by increases on the United States lines and the system revenues increased from \$55,147,657 to \$55,649,743. Operating expenses were reduced and the operating income debit was reduced from \$7,029,549 to \$4,668,461.

CANADIAN PACIFIC RAILWAY COMPANY: Gross revenues were reduced by \$283,211 or from \$10,507,790 in 1938 to \$10,224,579 but operating expenses were reduced by \$718,717, increasing the operating income from \$499,552 to \$915,149. For January - April, gross revenues were reduced from \$40,903,673 in 1938 to \$39,791,092, but through reductions in operating expenses the operating income was increased from \$1,747,502 to \$2,381,070.

Please note the cents have been omitted from revenues, expenses and income items, and ton miles and passenger miles have been stated in thousands.
