## OPERATING REVENUES, EXPENSES \& STATISTICS

 RAILWAYS IN CANADA WITH ANNUAL OPERATING REVENUES OF \$500,000 OR OVERFOR THE LIONTH OF JANUARY, 1940.

Canadian railways earned $\$ 30,494,952$ in January as against º $^{2} 2,797,552$ in January 1939. This was an increase of $\$ 6,697,400$ or 28.1 per cent. Operating expenses were increased by $\$ 2,932,433$ and the operating income was increased from a debit of 3881,981 to a credit of $\$ 3,372,892$. Freight traffic measured in ton miles increased by 49.2 per cent, and passenger traffic.was heavier than in 1959 by 17.6 per cent. The total payroll increased from $\mathbf{~} 14,619,466$ to $\$ 16,278,027$ or by 11.3 per cent and the number of employees increased from 110,511 to 119,264 or by 7.9 per cent.

CANADIAN NATIONAL RALLHAYS: Gross revenues of Canadian lines amounted to $\$ 14,644,748$ compared with $171,029,699$ in 1939, an increase of $\$ 3,615,049$ or 32.8 per cent. Operatine expenses
 of $\$ 1,316,300$ to a credit of, $\$ 684,855$. The increase in freicht traffic wes 61.2 per cent but freight revenues increased only 38.7 per cent. Passenger miles increased by 33.5 per cent and passenger revenues by 19.7 per cent. All four lines in the United States shoped larger gross revenues and all but the Duluth winnipeg and Pacific showed improvements in operating incomes, raising the system gross revenues to $417,601,735$ and the operating income to $\$ 939,487$ compared with $\$ 13,495,005$ and a debj.t of $\$ 1,210,828$ respectively for Janury 1939 .

CANADIAN PACIFIC PAIJ,WII COUThNY: Gross revenues incrensed to $12,288,946$ from $\$ 9,772,432$ in 1939 and with an incresse in operating expenses of only $, 1,1 ; 5,206$ the operating income increased from $\$ 461,003$ to $\$ 1,828,506$. Freicht traffic incrensed by 42.9 per cent and passenger traffic wes hervier by 17.3 per cent.
