RAILWAYS IN CANADA WITH ANNUAL OPERATING REVENUES OF $\$ 500,000$ OR OVER

Cose revenues for (ianadian railrays for October amounted to $440,504,496$ as againat $=39,681,437$ in .1939. Al though this was e gein of only s823,059 it was the largegt October revenue since lg30. with a normal movement of western grain revenues would have been considerably higher. Operating expenses were up by gl, 587,892, raducing the operating income from $121,221,517$ in 1939 to $\$ 10,257,472$. Tons of revenue freight carried showed a reduetion of 4.6 per cent and ton miles were leas by 5.5 per cent. Passengers carried increased by 166,753 or 13.6 per cent and passenger miles increased by 50.3 per cent. $20 t a l$ pay roll amounted to $277,463,109$, an increase of 3,4 per cont for an Incrasse of 1.6 per cent in the number of employess or from 125,122 to 127,137.

For January - Uctober gross revenuas were $\$ 345,731,080$ in 1940 , and $8295,590,868$ in i939, and the operatIng income was $\$ 54,187,038$ as against $\$ 28,367,217$.

CANADIAN NATLONAL RAILMAYS: Gross revenues of Canadian 1ines increasec from \$16,996,250 in October 1939 to $\$ 19,845,595$ or by 4.5 per cent, and operating expenses increased from $\$ 14,194,078$ to $\$ 15,399,680$, reducing the operating income from $\$ 4,381,193$ to $\$ 4,052,305$.

The Duluth, Winnipeg and Pacific showed a reduction $1 n$ gross revenues but the other three lines in the United States showed increases and the system total increased from $821,943,155$ in 1939 to $\$ 22,984,979$, and with 1 inger operating expenses the operating income was reduced from $\$ 4,665,478$ to $\$ 4,430,988$.

For January - October the system gross revenues increased from $\$ 164,189,092$ in 1939 to $8201,400,970$ and the operating income increased from $\$ 5,215,058$ to $825,787,451$.

CANADIAS PACEIC FAILMAT CO: GOOSE FOFenves amounted to $816,957,595$ as against $\$ 16,781,250$ in October 1939 and With an incresse of $\$ 307,815$ In operating expenses the operating income decined from $85,844,166$ to $\$ 5,470,659$. Freight traffic measured in ton miles decreased by 10.3 per cent but passenger traffic increased by 55.3 per cent.

For Jenuery - October gross revenues increased Irom $2123,020,864$ in 1939 to $5139,255,663$ and the operating income from $\$ 18,519,578$ to $\$ 25,760,615$.
