# OPERATING REVENUES, EXPENSES \& STATISTICS RAILWAYS IN CANADA WITH ANNUAL OPERATING REVENUES OF $\$ 500,000$ OR OVER 

FOR THE MONTH OF MARCH, 1940

Canadian railways earned $\$ 30,145,342$ in March as against $\$ 25,699,829$ in March last year. Operating expenses increased from $\$ 24,853,201$ to $\$ 25,643,368$ and the operating income was increased from $\$ 192,464$ in 1939 to $\$ 3,270,898$. Freight traffic was 25 per cent heavier than a year ago and passenger traffic measured in pessenger miles increased by 32.4 par cent, although the number of passengers increased by only 13.5 per cent; the average journey was 80.9 miles as againsto 69.4 miles in 1939. The pay-roll amounted to $\$ 16,083,663$ as against $\$ 15,285,036$ in 1939 . For the three months, January, February and Merch gross reverues were $\$ 90,641,478$ as against $\$ 72,149,340$ and the operating income increased from a debit of $\$ 1,679,953$ to a credit of $\$ 9,978,904$, an fmprovement of $\$ 11,658,857$.

CANADIAN NATIONAL RAILHAIS: GFOBE revemues of the Canadian lines increased from $\$ 12,067,302$ in March 1959 to $\$ 15,117,171$ and with operating expenses up by only $\$ 948,908$ the operating income was $\$ 989,084$ as againgt a debit of $\$ 1,219,037$. Each of the four United States lines showed Larger gross revenues and all but the New EIgland lines showed improved operating incomes. The system gross revenues were $\$ 18,049,624$ as against $\$ 14,632,661$ in 1989 and the oparating income was $\$ 1,308,280$ as against a debit of $\$ 1,051,218$. For the first quarter, system gross revenues increased from $\$ 41,197,441$ last jear to $\$ 53,374,115$ and the operating income increased from a debit of $\$ 4,327,619$ to a credit of $\$ 3,306,407$ an increase of $\$ 7,634,026$.

CANADIAN PACIFIC HAILBAY COMPANY: Groes revenues for March were $\$ 11,501,467$ compered with $\$ 10,506,240$ In 1939 and with operating expenses up by only $\$ 256,078$ or 2.7 per cent the operating income increased from $\$ 773,551$ to $\$ 1,501,561$. For January - March, grose revenues were $\$ 35,748,120$ in 1940 and $\$ 29,566,514$ in 1939 and the operating income was $\$ 5,202,489$ in 1940 and $\$ 1,467,922$ in 1939 .
