## OPERATING REVENUES, EXPENSES \& STATISTICS RAILWAYS IN CANADA <br> WITH ANNUAL OPERATING REVENUES OF \$500,000 OR OVER

FOR THE MONTH OF MAY, 1940.

Cross earnings of Canadian rail mags for May amounted to $854,629,641$ as against $\$ 29,680,004$ in Hey 1939. Operating expenses increased from $\$ 25,260,941$ to $\$ 27,802,566$, and the operating income was increased from $\$ 3,169,748$ to $\$ 5,759,782$. Freight traffic was heavier than in 1959 by 20.5 per cent and passenger traffic increased by 5.1 par cent. The pay-roll increased from $\$ 16,249,014$ to $\$ 17,609,596$ or by 8.4 per cent for an increase in the number of employees of 10,111 or from 121,175 to 151,288. For January - May, gross revenues increased fran $\$ 127,020,440$ in 1989 to $\$ 155,286,865$ and the operating income from $\$ 2,558,854$ to $\$ 18,815,505$.

CANADIAN NATIONAL RAILMAZB: Gross revenues of Canadian lines were increased from $\$ 14,448,986$ in May 1959 to $\$ 17,877,796$ or by 20 per cent. With operating expenses up by only $\$ 1,277,651$ the operating income was increased from $\$ 796,114$ to $\$ 2,450,848$. Freight trafilc measured in ton mile increased by 51.8 per cent and due to longer haul passenger traffic, passenger miles increased by 16.4 per cent. All four ines in the United States showed increases in gross revenues and operating incomes raising the system gross revenue fran $\$ 16,842,266$ to $\$ 20,281,555$, and the operating income from $\$ 789,785$ to $\$ 2,810,657$. For January - May, system gross revenues were increased Prom $\$ 72,482,009$ to $\$ 21,521,614$ and the operating income was increased from a debit in 1959 of $\$ 5,878,676$ to a credit of \$7,121,899, an improvement of $\$ 71,000,575$.

GANADIAN PACIFIC RAIWAI COHPANY: Gross revenues increased from $\$ 12,076,469$ to $\$ 15,550,825$ or by 12.2 per cent and the operating income was increased from $\$ 1,906,956$ to $42,464,384$. Freight traffic increased by 9.1 per cent but passenger traffic decreased by 4.1 par cent. For January May, gross revenues were $\$ 61,388,207$ in 1940 and $\$ 51,867,562$ in 2939 and the operating income increased from $4,288,027$ in 1959 to $\$ 9,712,955$.
